From POD 2 water is withdrawn from the Rogue River via pump and pipelines to the place of use where what is applied by a mobile high pressure sprinklers. The sprinklers are moved around with above ground handline as necessary to cover the pasture in irrigation. 2dp

This POD is also coincident with Certificate 57713.

POD 3 serves the land south of the Rogue River. From POD 3 water is withdrawn from the fork of the Rogue River and Rogue River Infiltration pond via pump and pipelines to the place of use where what is applied by a mobile high pressure sprinklers. The sprinklers are moved around with above ground handline as necessary to cover the pasture in irrigation. This POD is also coincident with Certificates 44184 and 82028.
