Dear Mr. Woosley:

We are prepared to send you the findings of the survey made in connection with your Permits Numbered 40923 and 40924; however, a clarification of use of water is required.

In the space provided for remarks for your Application No. 54268, Permit No. 40923, you made a statement to the effect that you would be willing to withdraw your request in favor of Fat Elk Drainage District's permit. A copy of the statement is enclosed. We issued Permit Number 41158 to the District and it is my understanding that the drainage ditch described in your Permit No. 40923 is also used by the District. Since your lands are served by the District, your Permit No. 40923 serves no purpose and should be cancelled. I have enclosed a partially completed cancellation form for this reason.

Upon receipt of the signed cancellation form, our records will be changed accordingly and the lands described in your Permit No. 40923 would then be covered under Fat Elk Drainage District's Permit Number 41158.

Should you decide not to cancel your permit, we will delete your project from the District's permit.

Further action will be withheld on your files for a reasonable length of time pending your reply.

We have again received your applications which were filed as No. 54268, No. 54269, and No. 54270. We also received the map describing the proposed projects.

Since I was not certain as to your proposed uses, I phoned you on Monday, October 18, 1976 to discuss the projects.

Application No. 54268 was filed for irrigation from a drainage ditch. As I understand your project, you intend to use the water from this drain ditch, which is located on your property, to supplement the project being proposed by Fat Elk Drainage District. I understand you will be irrigating all of your irrigable land lying southeasterly from Pulaski Creek. You also intend to put in a small pump and pump water into livestock watering watering troughs from this ditch.

If this is the case, I have amended your application to request 0.88 cubic foot per second of water from the drain ditch for irrigation of 8 acres and also 0.01 cubic foot per second of water from the drain ditch for livestock watering. Since the livestock portion was added October 18, livestock water from the drain ditch will receive this priority date.

Application No. 54270 requests water from an unnamed stream to be used for domestic purposes. Again, as I understand it, you will be piping water from the unnamed stream to your house and also to the barn area. Water will be used for domestic purposes for one family, including irrigation of a lawn and garden. You will also use the water in the barn area for stock purposes.

I have amended applications No. 54270 to now request 0.01 cubic foot per second of water for domestic use for one family including irrigation of lawn and garden and also 0.01 cubic foot per second of water for livestock watering. Since stock water was added to this application October 18, stockwater from the unnamed stream will receive this priority date.

Application No. 54269 requests water from Pulaski Creek for a supplemental supply to the unnamed stream. However, according to our conversation by telephone, your only proposed use of water from Pulaski Creek will be for livestock water. Therefore, this application has been amended to request 0.01 cubic foot per second of water from Pulaski Creek for livestock watering. This application also has a priority date of October 18, the date the application was amended.

Your application No. 54268 for the drain ditch requires an additional \$3.00 irrigation recording fee and also a \$15.00 recording fee for stock water. Your application No. 54270 for domestic use including irrigation of lawn and garden and livestock watering requires an additional permit recording fee of \$15.00 for the stock. Therefore, total fees of \$33.00 must be submitted before these permits can be issued,

If you disagree with the amendments to these applications, please contact me, in which case, the applications will be returned to you for your approval.

This will acknowledge your maps, legal descriptions, fees of \$112.00 and 3 applications for permits.

Your application for a permit to appropriate 1/80th cubic foot per second of water for irrigation and 1/100th cfs for domestic purposes from Fat Elk Drainage District and privately owned and maintained drainage ditch for irrigation of 70 acres and domestic use for an unspecified number of families has been filed as No. 54268.

Your application for a permit to appropriate 1/100th cubic foot per second of water from Pulaski Creek for domestic supplies for an unspecified number of families including the irrigation of a lawn and garden and also irrigation of 5 acres has been filed as No. 54269.

Your application for a permit to appropriate 1/100th cubic foot per second from an unnamed stream for domestic supplies for an unspecified number of families including irrigation of lawn and garden and irrigation of 5 acres has been filed as No. 54270.

The maps to support your applications must be prepared with reference to the government survey showing the Section lines and quarter-quarter section lines in the vicinity of each project. The maps which you have submitted generally meet our requirements. However, they do not identify their relationship with reference to the government survey. Your maps appear to be prepared with reference to county records, indicating the county tax lot numbers for each parcel. Since we do not have county records, your maps must be amended to show their relationship to the government survey.

Application No. 54268 requires some correction and additional information.

You have identified the source of water for this application as being Fat Elk Drainage District and privately owned and maintained drainage ditch. Before a permit will be issued, it will be necessary that you provide us with notification from the owners of the ditch, including the District, stating that they do not object to your proposed source and use of water.

Item No. 2 of the application requests a permit to appropriate 1/80th cubic foot per second of water. If this is "per acre", it should be so stated under Item No. 2. Otherwise, for 70 acres 0.88 cfs should be adequate.

Item No. 8 of the application must identify the land to be irrigated with reference to the government survey, showing the 40-acre tracts or quarter-quarter sections in each Section where irrigation will occur. In this case, it appears that you intend to irrigate 35 acres in tax lot 9150, which appears to be the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13. It also appears that you intend to irrigate 35 acres located in tax lot 9160 and 9167-1. If this is the case, it appears that these 2 tax lots are incorporated with in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 14.

It also will be necessary to identify the intended acres to be irrigated on your map. This can be done by showing the number of acres to be irrigated and shading or cross-hatching the intended area. Pages No. 7 and 8 of the enclosed booklet should be of assistance to you in preparing the proper maps.

Application No. 54269 also requires some additional information and correction. The map in support of this application must also be prepared with reference to the government survey. The map must show on it the location of each house where water will be used as well as the location of the acreage intended to be irrigated and the number of acres. The acreage to be irrigated can be identified by either shading or cross-hatching the area.

The location of the point of diversion from Pulaski Creek must be shown on the map and its location be in agreement with Item No. 4 of the application. In this case, it appears that the diversion point would be located approximately 1800 feet south rather than 2440 feet south from the Section corner.

Item No. 8 of the application must be completed to show the location where water will be used for domestic purposes as well as the location of the 5 acres to be irrigated. If the use is intended in the westerly portion of tax lot 9160, this use would be located within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 14.

Item No. 10b must be completed to state the number of families to be supplied with water.

You might also wish to review the quantity of water requested under Item No. 2 of the application. 0.01 cubic foot per second of water would be adequate for domestic supplies for two families, including the irrigation of a lawn and garden. However, if it is your intention to irrigate 5 acres of land, you may wish to request a greater quantity of water.

The filing fee for domestic use including irrigation of a lawn and garden is the \$20.00 examination fee and \$15.00 permit recording fee. However, if you intend to irrigate 5 acres of land, under a permit issued in approval of your application, it will be necessary to submit an irrigation permit recording fee of \$10.00.

Your application No. 54270 also requires some additional information and correction. It appears from this application and map that this is intended to be a supplemental supply for the same houses and land as described by your application No. 54269 or possibly vice versa. If this is the case, your primary source of water should be identified and the supplemental source identified on the applications.

This application also requests 1/100 cubic foot per second of water, which would be adequate for domestic use for 2 families including the irrigation of a lawn and garden, but would not be sufficient for irrigation of 5 acres of land. Therefore, you may wish to request a greater quantity of water.

The map in support of this application must also be prepared with reference to the government survey and locate the point of diversion and proposed place of use accordingly. The point of diversion, houses and acreage to be irrigated must be identified on the map. You may also wish to review the information given under Item No. 4 of the application, since it appears that the diversion point would be located approximately 1500 feet south of the Section corner rather than 2940 feet as shown.

Item No. 8 of the application must also be completed to indicate the place of use of water with reference to the government survey.

Please complete Item No. 10b to indicate the number of families to be supplied with water.
