Gentlemen:

In response to the request contained in your letter of April 9 our records have been checked, and it is found that Certificate No. 8617 has been issued to the City of Dundee in confirmation of Permit No. 6978, granting a right to the use of 0.05 second-foot of water from two springs, tributary of Otter Brook, for domestic supply, fruit and nut dryers and a fruit packing house within the $W\frac{1}{2}W\frac{1}{2}$, Section 25, $E\frac{1}{2}E\frac{1}{2}$, Section 26, $NE\frac{1}{4}NE\frac{1}{4}$, Section 35, and $NW\frac{1}{4}NW\frac{1}{4}$, Section 36, Township 3 South, Range 3 West, W. M. The springs are described as being located within the $NW\frac{1}{4}NE\frac{1}{4}$, Section 27, and $SW\frac{1}{4}SE\frac{1}{4}$, Section 22, Township 3 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

Certificate No. 8781 has been issued to the City of Dundee in confirmation of Permit No. 5952, granting a right to the use of 0.5 second-foot of water from two springs, tributary of Otter Creek, for municipal supply within the $W\frac{1}{2}W\frac{1}{2}$, Section 25, $E\frac{1}{2}E\frac{1}{2}$, Section 26, $NE\frac{1}{4}NE\frac{1}{4}$, Section 35, and $NW\frac{1}{4}NW\frac{1}{4}$, Section 36, Township 3 South, Range 3 West, W. M. The springs are described as being located within the $SE\frac{1}{4}NW\frac{1}{4}$ and $NW\frac{1}{4}NE\frac{1}{4}$, Section 27, Township 3 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

Certificate No. 8781 has a priority of June 20, 1923, and Certificate No. 8617 has a priority of March 25, 1929.

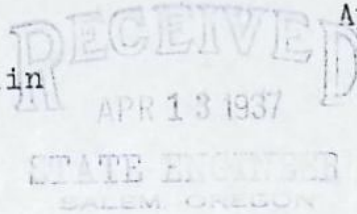
