Gentlemen: ATTENTION: Mr. Morris D. Parks, Mayor.

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of June 6th with which you enclosed an application in the name of the Town of Dundee for a permit to appropriate water from a certain spring supplying Otter Brook; together with fees in the amount of \$10.00 for which Receipt No. 24573 is enclosed.

The application has been filed and given Number 18173. It has been checked over and found to be not quite complete. Under Item 1, since the spring is known locally as Mossy Spring, I believe it is advisable that it be so described under this item.

The amount of water which it is desired the application should cover should be indicated under Item 2.

Under Item 7 the difference in elevation between the intake and the lower end of the pipe described should be noted.

Under Item 8, the 40-acre tracts, section, township and range within which the water covered by the application is to be used, should be indicated, and the map accompanying the application should show the location of the place of use as to 40-acre tracts, section, township and range, as explained on pages 6 and 7 of the enclosed copy of the Rules and Regulations of the State Engineer.

There appears to be no water right of record in this office in the name of the City of Dundee covering the use of water for the operation of hydraulic rams, as mentioned in your letter. This suggestion is made with the thought that your city may wish to protect itself in the use of the water for operation of the rams. Of course, if the water has been used for this purpose since prior to 1909 when the Oregon Water Code was adopted, it is probable that

under the law a vested right exists and a filing would be unnecessary.
