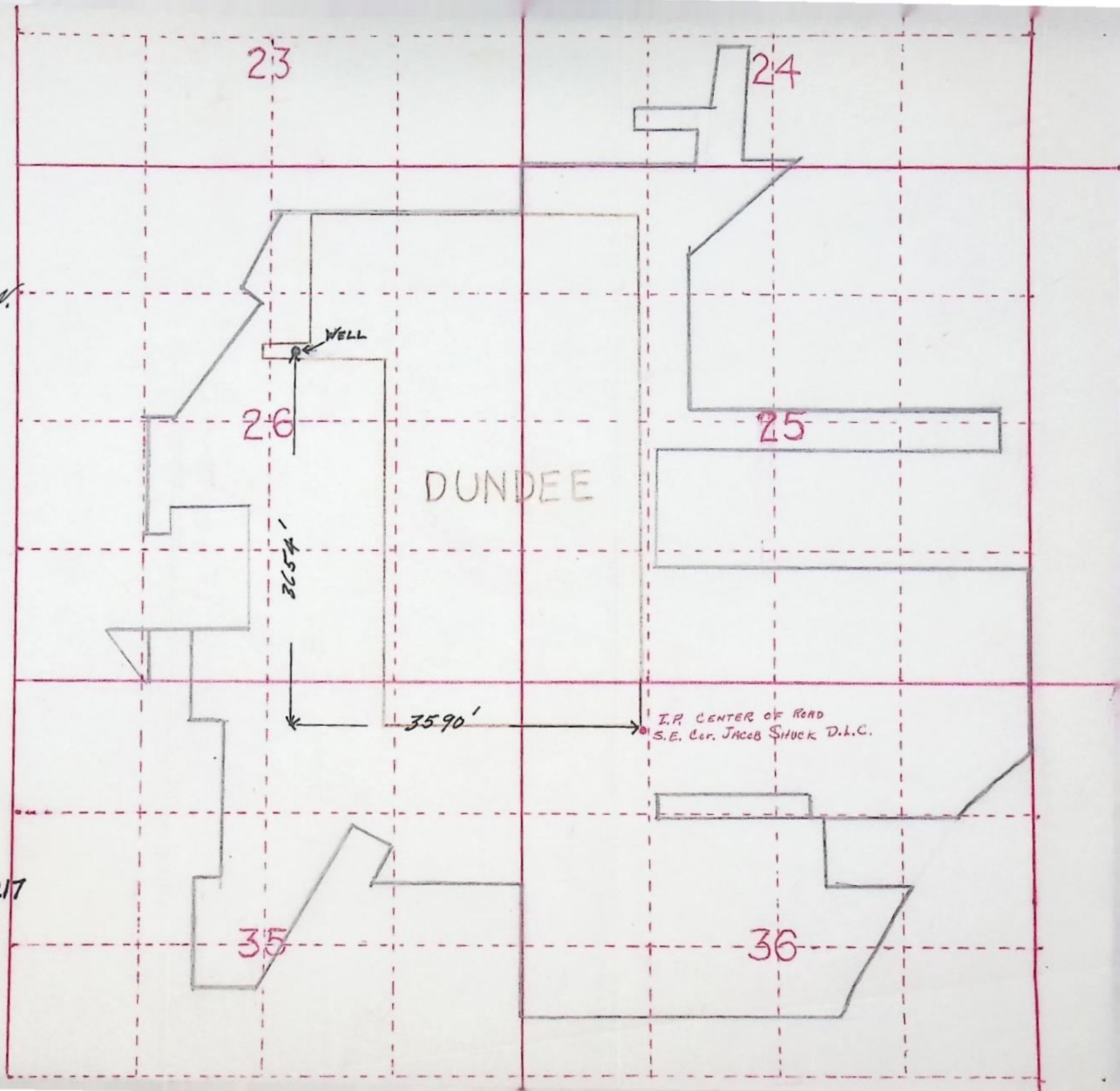

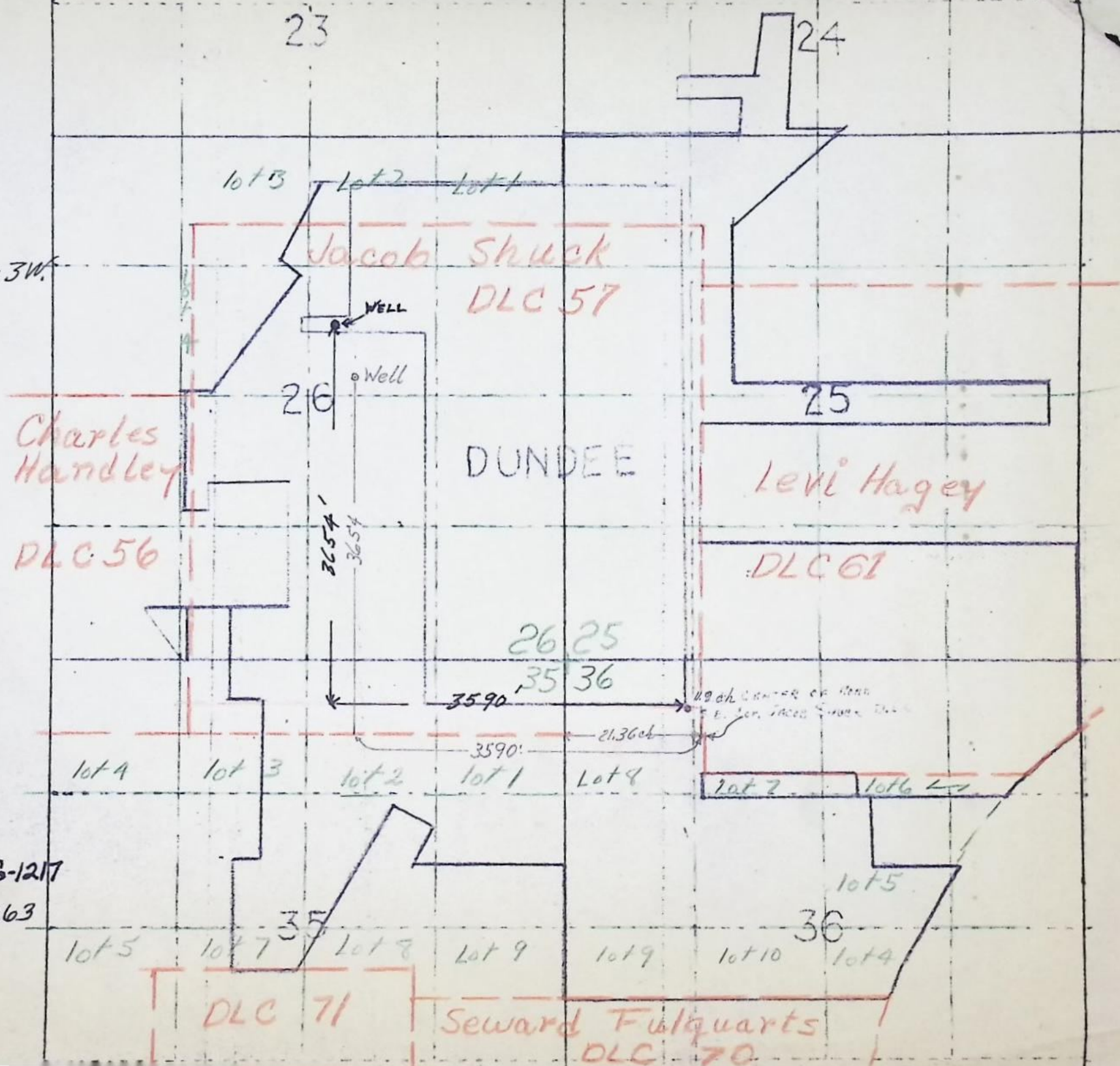

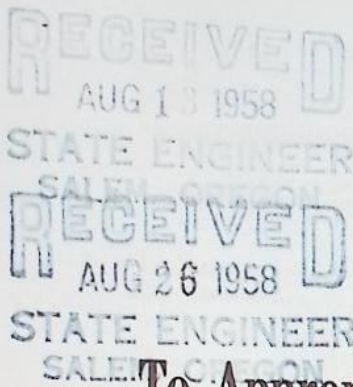

This will acknowledge receipt of an application in the name of the City of Dundee for a permit for the construction of a well and the appropriation therefrom of 80 gallons of water per minute for municipal use and a listing of the previous rights held by the city. Since the fees necessary to the application were not received with it, it can not yet be filed. The application has been given a preliminary examination and the following defects are noted:

Map: A map of the proposed project showing the location of the well and the approximate location of the works to connect the well with the previous existing city water system must be submitted. The basic requirements of the map can be found on pages 3 and 4 of the enclosed copy of the Rules and Regulations.

Application Item 4: Unless three prints of a subdivision plat are submitted in lieu of the transparent map it will be necessary to list the location of the well in reference to an established corner of the U. S. Public Land Survey.

Item 12: The area of municipal use should be listed as being within specific 1/16ths of a section.

Fees: The total of fees necessary to the application as it is written would be \$20.

The application and the accompanying list are returned herewith.

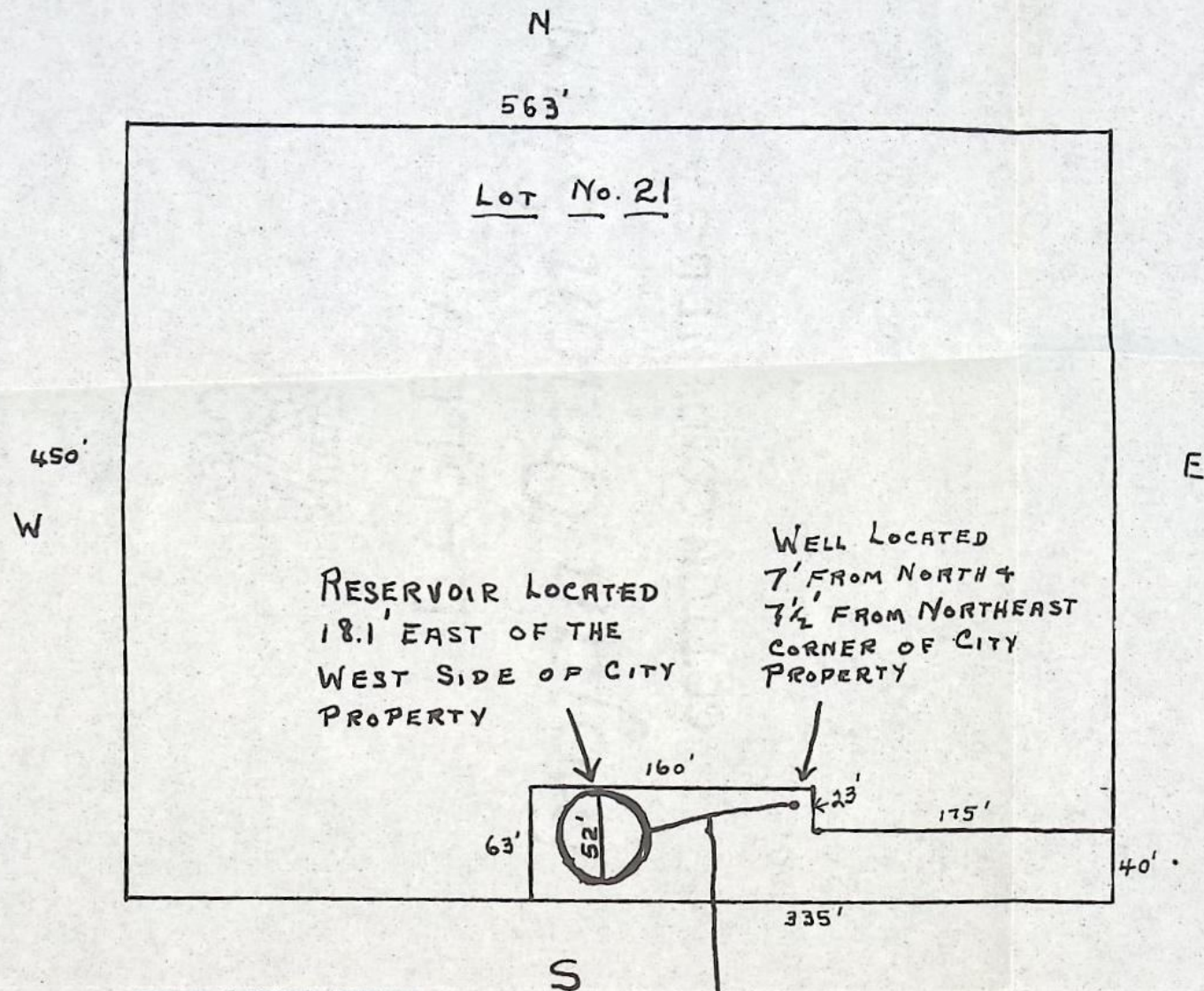
