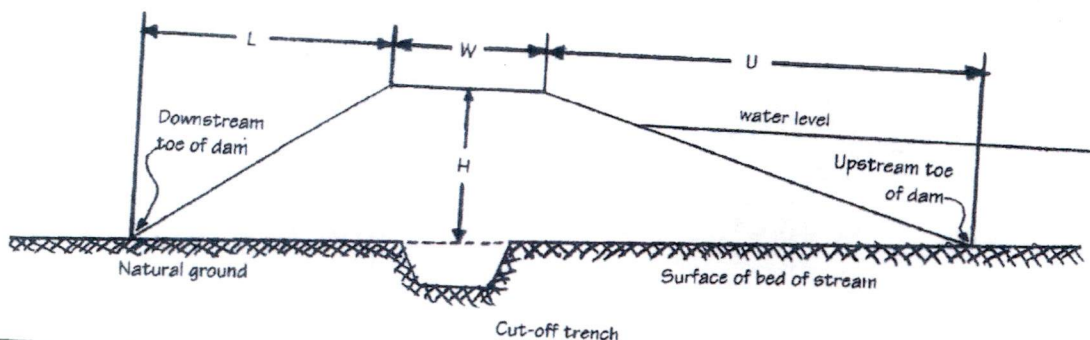

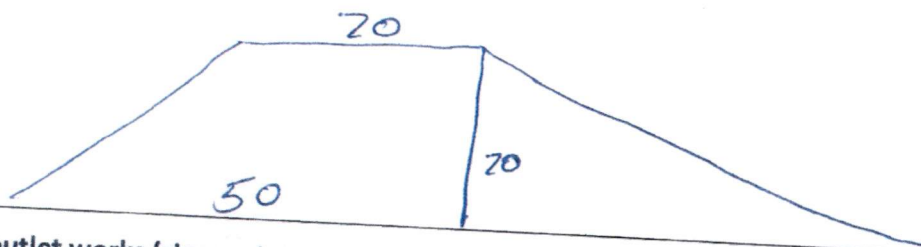

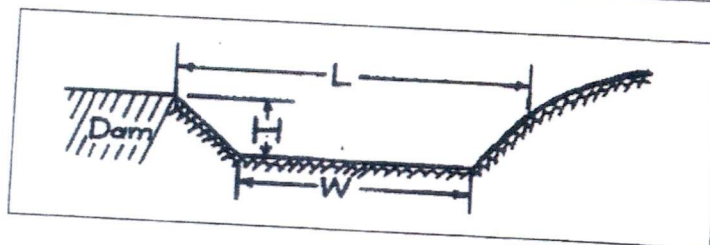

Our records have been changed accordingly and the original request is enclosed. Receipt number 146396 covering the recording fee is also enclosed.

A permit is not a perfected water right and has conditions and timelines that must be satisfied prior to a Certificate of Water Right being issued. Please review the permit to be familiar with the conditions and timelines contained in the permit.

Please note that this permit required complete application of water to the proposed use by February 8, 2023, and within one year after complete application of water to the proposed use, the permittee shall submit a claim of beneficial use, which includes a map and report, prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner (CWRE). A claim of beneficial use was received and returned to the permit holder of record on August 1, 2024, due to map deficiencies. As of this date, the claim of beneficial use has not been returned to the Department.
