

- b. Groundwater is available in the amount requested for this emergency, temporary use;
 - c. The proposed use will not injure other water rights; and
 - d. The proposed use complies with other rules of the Commission.
8. The Department has considered the need for water because of the drought emergency and the short-term nature of the proposed emergency use and determined that the use would not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

The application will not cause injury to existing water rights and will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest (OAR 690-019-0040(3)).

ORDER

Application G-19549 is approved, and Permit G-19063 is issued as limited by the conditions contained therein.
