I assume that the right in which you are interested is the one to irrigate 30 acres of land from Jackson Creek in the name of H. E. Staffanson.

This right was completed and confirmed by issuance of a certificate recorded on page 11115, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and when the property bearing such a completed water right is sold, the right passes with the property and no assignment is considered necessary because water in this state is by law appurtenant to the land.

Dear Sir:

This will acknowledge receipt of your application for permit to appropriate $5/8$ second-foot of water from Jackson Creek for irrigation purposes, together with your remittance in the sum of \$9.50 as fees. Receipt No. 16294 is enclosed.

The application, which has been given No. 15014, appears to be satisfactory in most respects with the exception of the description of the diversion works and location of the place of use. It is being returned with the request that you give a general description of the dam or other diversion works which you propose to build under Item 6, and show the smallest legal subdivisions or forty-acre tracts within which the lands to be irrigated lie. These would appear to be 19 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 35, and 11 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26.

The application has been endorsed so that in order to retain its priority it must be returned within 30 days or on or before August 7th.
