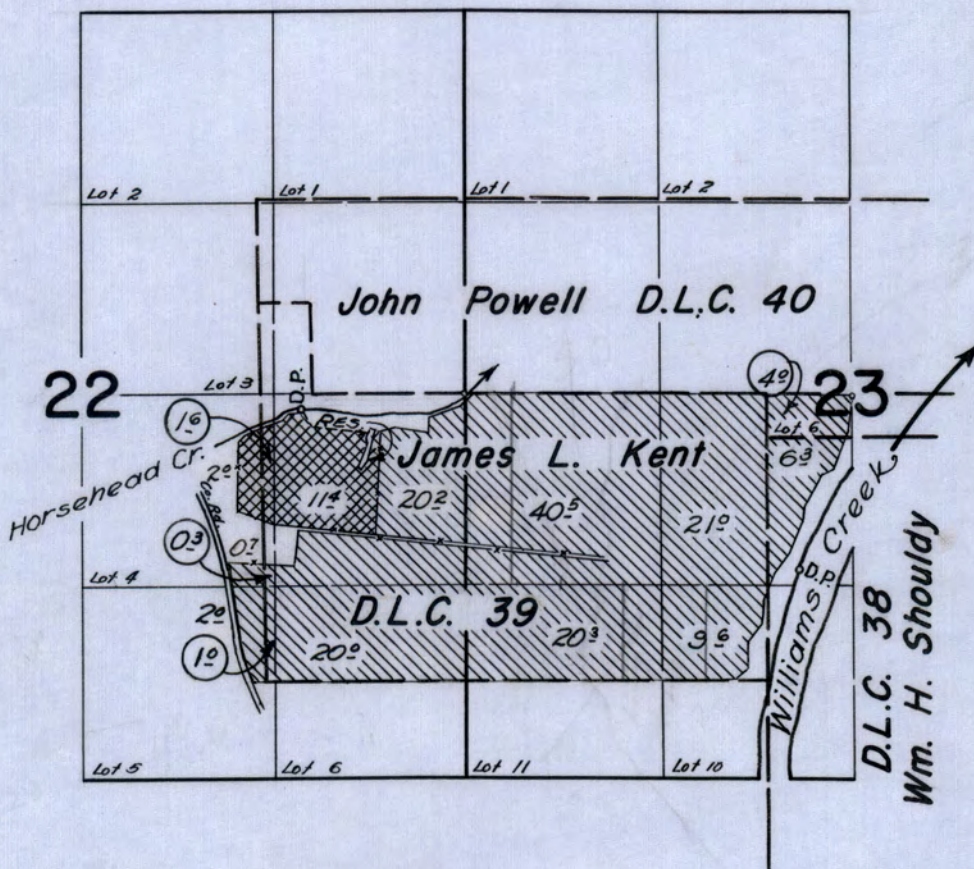

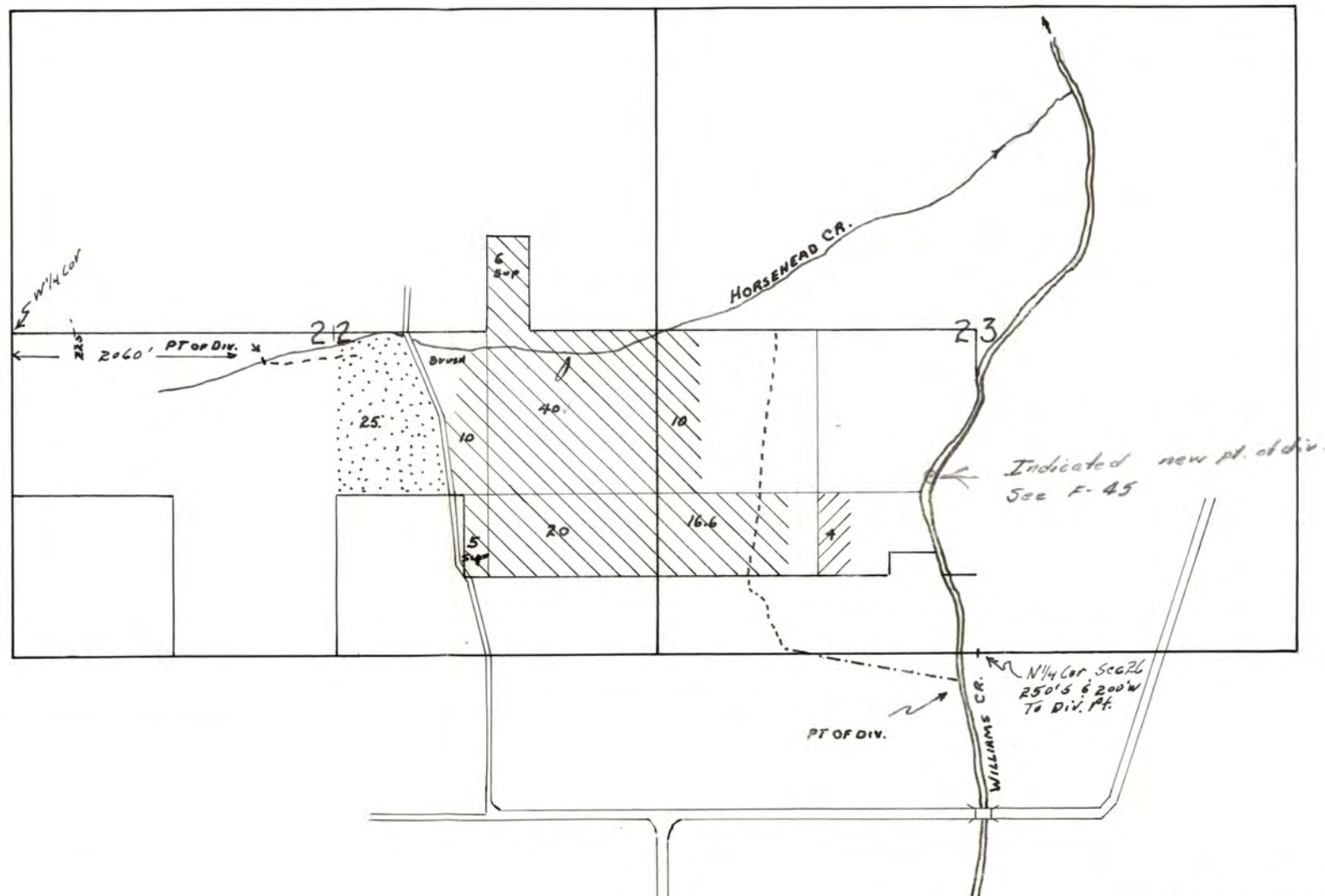

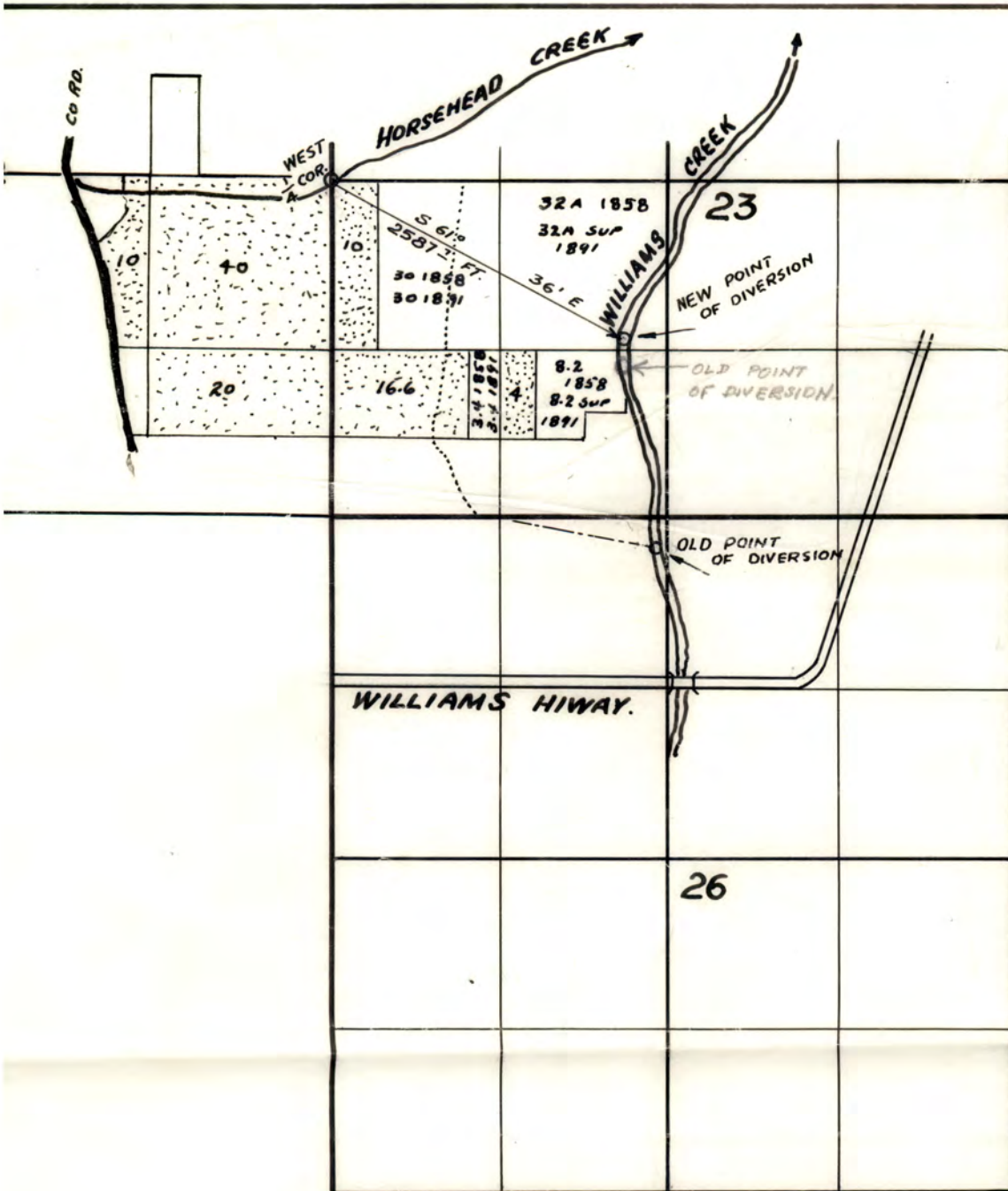

Dear Bob,

I have examined the records in this office and can find no reference to a water right appurtenant to the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

It appears that this land, if irrigated, would receive water through the Blodgett and Gotcher or Powell Creek Ditch. This would be from Powell Creek. You might examine the original claim of water right under Certificate numbered 16335. This certificate covers the irrigation of lands in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27 under priority of 1860. There is the possibility that the lands in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27 were included in the original claim but inadvertently omitted in the decree. On the other hand, the claimant may have failed to submit a claim in the adjudication procedure. In any event, the lands in question do not now have a right for their irrigation according to the records in this office.

Dear Bob:

Permit No. 27075 initially included Horsehead Creek and Williams Creek as sources for irrigation and supplemental irrigation. The reference to Horsehead Creek was excluded from the proof because the area claimed irrigated from Horsehead Creek was not that described in the permit.

Apparently the area actually irrigated was not contemplated at the time of making application. The area in the permit to be irrigated from Horsehead Creek was west of the road, not as shown on the final proof map. The area described in the certificate is that irrigated from Williams Creek less the amount under an earlier right.

There is a right from Powell Creek under certificate 16335 for 40 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, which explains the supplemental in the certificate confirming permit No. 27075. There have been several transfers involving the original right and the certificate 16306, and soon we should issue the remaining right certificate following transfer application submitted by J. E. Ferrare and C. O. Booth, which certificate should take care of the earlier changes also.

If our records still don't agree please let me know and I will give you a run-down on what we have.

In checking our files, we find Abstract of Water Right and final proof map made by you July 17, 1963, in the name of J. E. & Dorothy Ferrare, application #34475, permit #27075, at variance.

The abstract shows the source as being Williams Creek only. The final proof map shows two sources - Williams Creek and Horsehead Creek. Our old card index shows Williams Creek and Horsehead Creek as the sources on the original application.

All of the supplemental from Williams Creek is from the same source as the 1858 primary right. There is also some 1891 supplemental from the same source. As such, of course, it is of no use. The Horsehead Creek diversion shown on the final proof survey would be of some value.

Would you look this over for me and let me know what you think.

Enclosed is a revised proof of appropriation of water under permit number 27075. Also enclosed is a revised final proof survey map showing 40.5 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 20.3 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23.

The information which you submitted to this office concerning the size of the forty-acre tracts in which we have adjusted the acreage indicates that the two forty-acre tracts have a width of 1337.45 feet. We have calculated the acreage based on a width of 1337.45 feet and the results are that in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ we obtained 40.5 acres and in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 20.3 acres. It is not our policy to calculate acreage to hundredths, so the acreage is only shown to the nearest tenth of an acre. The information you submitted shows the total acreage for the two adjusted acreages to be 61.43 acres, our adjusted total equals only 60.8 acres. Since our calculations are based on the information submitted by you, I am at a loss to determine why we have this discrepancy.

If the proof of appropriation is now acceptable to you, please date and sign it in the space provided near the bottom of the page and return it to this office. No further fees are required since you have already submitted the \$1.00 certificate recording fee.

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of March 1, 1965 in regard to permit number 27075.

Since the resurvey of your property by Claude E. Masters, Registered Land Surveyor shows that the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ are oversize, we will prepare another final proof map showing the additional acreage in these forties. Due to the oversize, the acreage in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ within the James L. Kent DLC will be increased slightly. No change will occur in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ as the irrigated lands do not extend to the boundary of those forty-acre tracts. The acreage listed in those forties reflects only the irrigated land and their total did not necessarily equal the total acreage of the entire forty.

A print of the adjusted survey and a new proof of appropriation showing the adjusted acreages will be mailed to you for your signature.

As you stated in your letter, no further fees will be required as you have already paid the certificate recording fee of \$1.00.

Dear Mr. Ferrare:-

I have made a transit and tape survey of that portion of your property lying within the bounds of Section 23, T. 38 S., R. 5 W., W. M. and find that the present boundaries and area is in accordance with the inclosed map.

You will note that, while the perimeter of your property is definitely established, the forty lines are indefinite except for your North line. This is due to the loss of the Section Corners, as established by the Surveyor General, on the South line of Section 23.

The acreage total is, however, definite, and I find the comparative figures of actual measured acreage and that shown by the State Engineer to be as follows:

The discrepancy in part is due to width of these subdivisions i.e. 1337.45 feet as to the State Engineers' 1320 feet.

Also, while the meadowland goes to the bank of Williams Creek except for a small portion in the Southeast corner, which is used as pasture.

Note also that an area washed away by the recent flood is not included in the above figures. This area amounts to approximately 1.43 Acres.

ORS 537.260 provides: "Whenever the time within which any appropriation under a permit should have been perfected has expired and the owner of the permit fails or refuses within three months thereafter to submit to the State Engineer proof of completion of the appropriation as required by ORS 537.230 and 537.250, the State Engineer may, after 60 days notice by registered mail, order the cancellation of the permit."

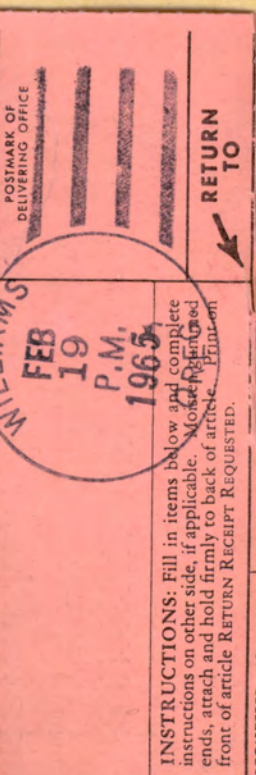

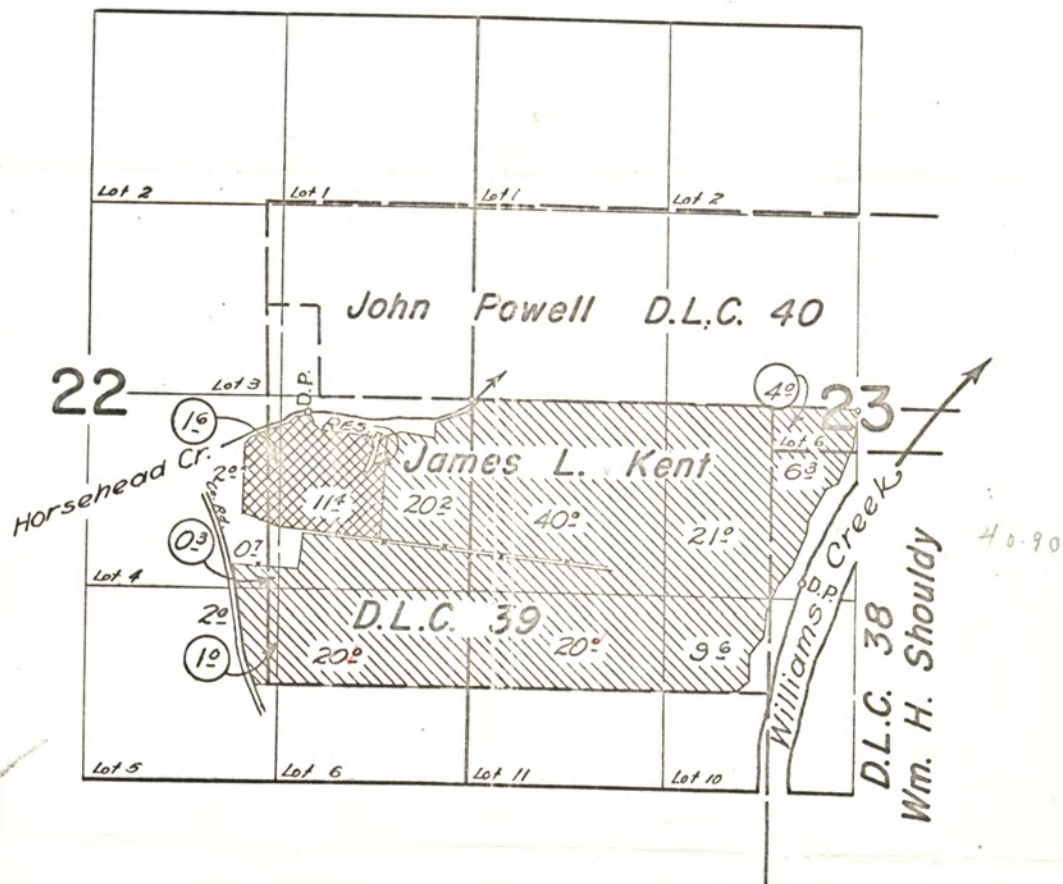

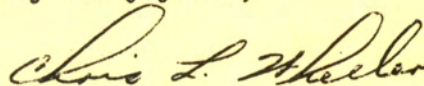

I have your letter of May 22, which was received in this office on June 25, together with a document assigning permit No. 27075 from Fred W. Richards to you. Since payment of the statutory recording fee was not received with the document of assignment it has not yet been recorded. The recording fees for recording such a document are \$1 for the first 100 words and ten cents for each additional 100 words or fraction thereof.

Since the document includes as an exhibit the entirety of the application permit, recording this document would be relatively expensive.

I am enclosing for your convenience our standard assignment form which when completed and properly signed can be recorded for \$1. The submitted documents are returned herewith.

In regard to the questions posed in your letter, under the provisions of permit No. 27075, beneficial irrigation at least once over of all the lands included in the permit should be accomplished on or before October 1, 1963. As soon as you have completed the beneficial use of water to the full extent intended under the provisions of the permit, this office should be so notified.

After we have been notified that use of water has been accomplished to the full extent intended, a final proof survey by a representative of this office is scheduled and a certificate of water right is issued in evidence of the completed right as determined by the survey.

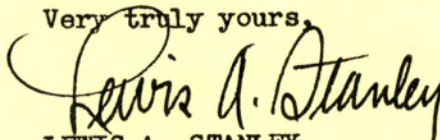

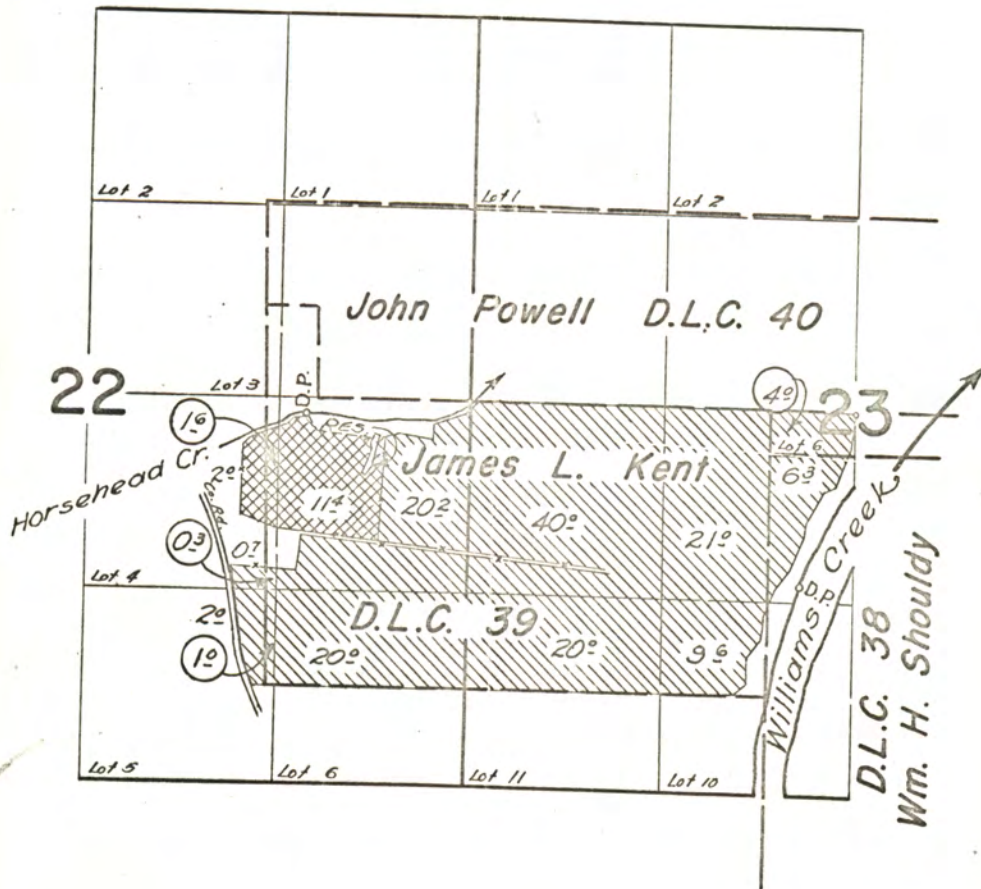
