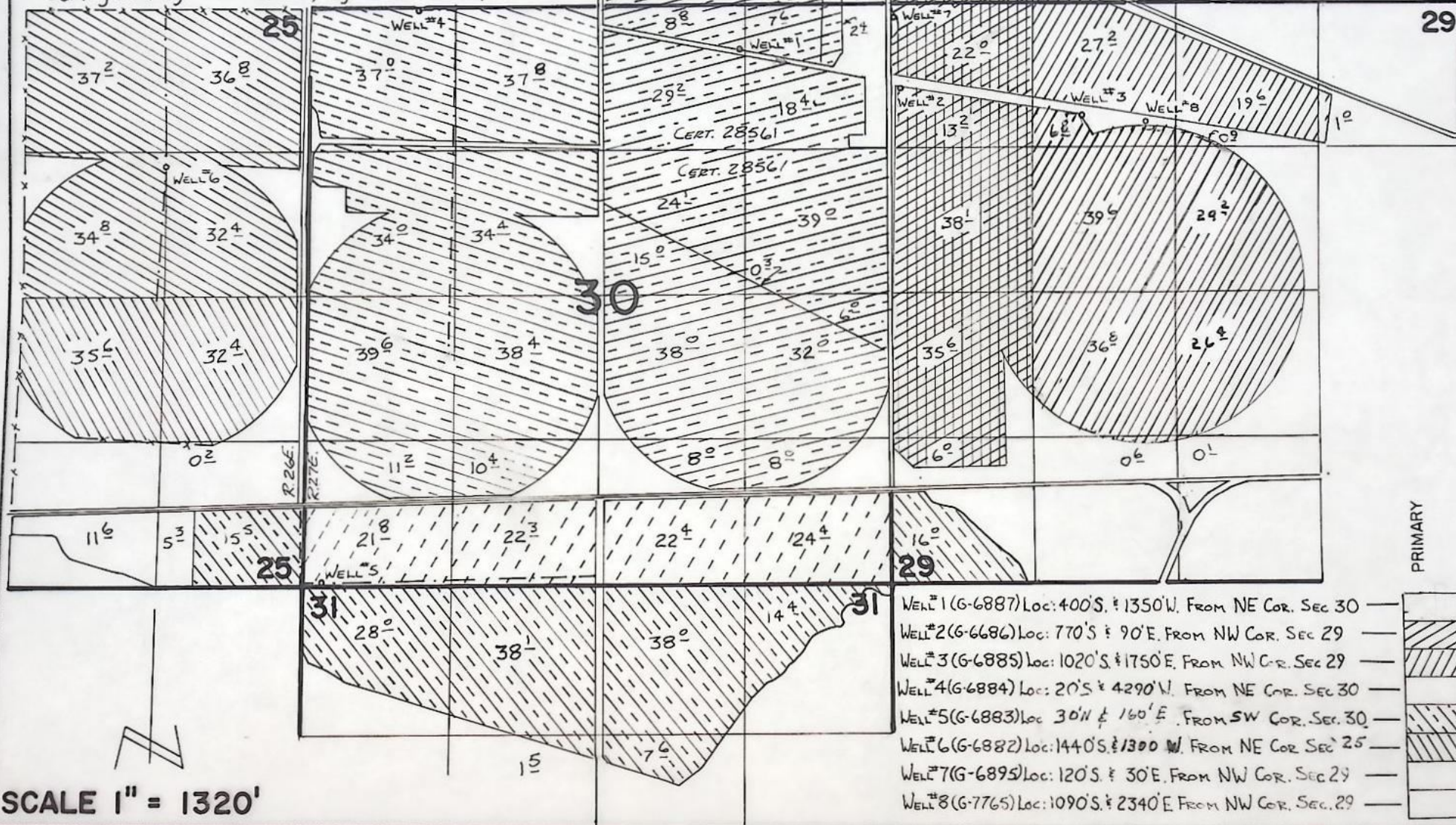

confirms the right to use the waters of HEGEWALD WELL 8 in the CHICKAHOMINY BASIN for the purpose of SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 314.6 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit G-7765. The date of priority is AUGUST 5, 1977. The right is limited to not more than 3.12 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 29, T 23 S, R 27 E, W.M.; 1090 FEET SOUTH & 2340 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER SECTION 29.

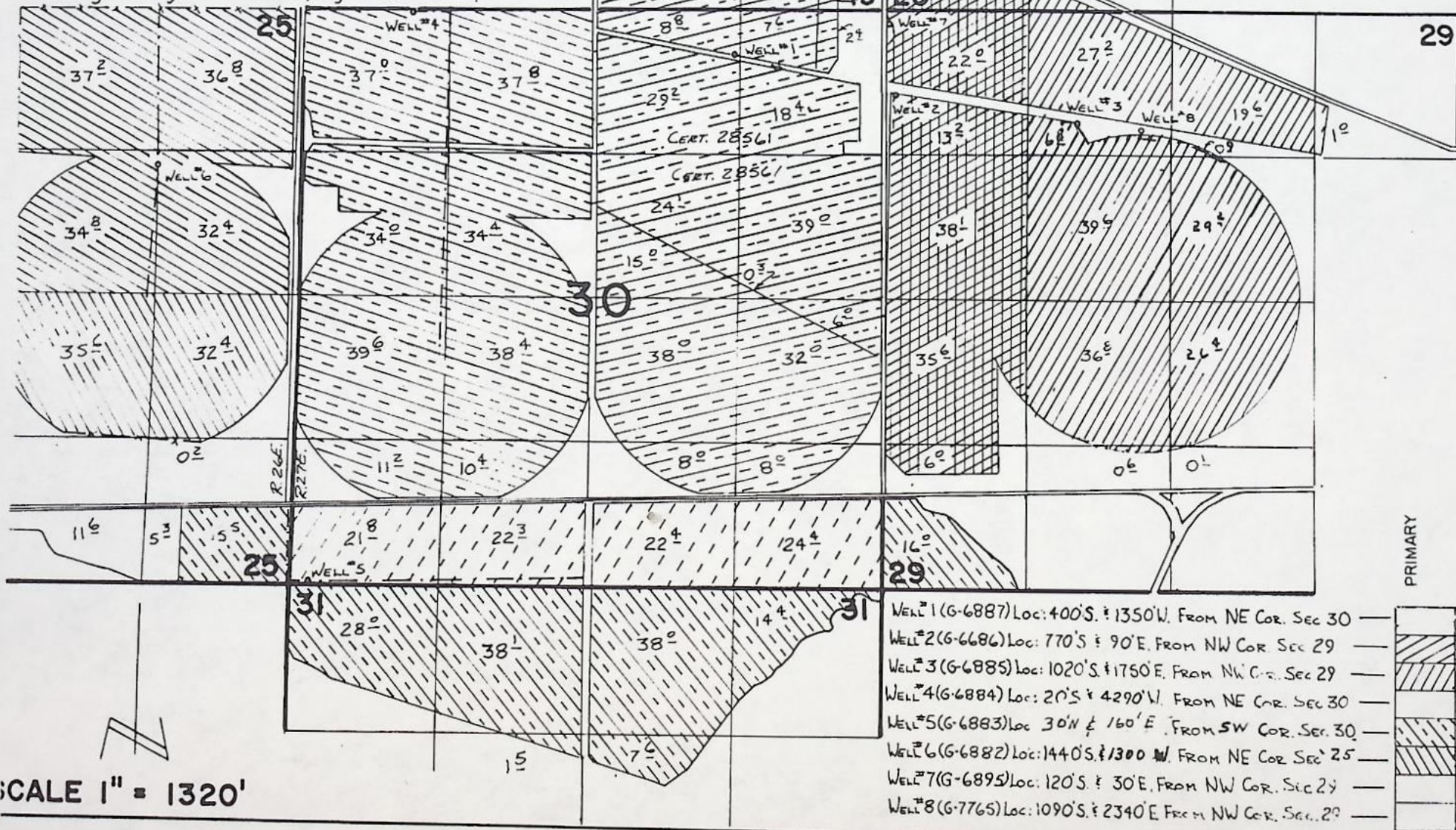

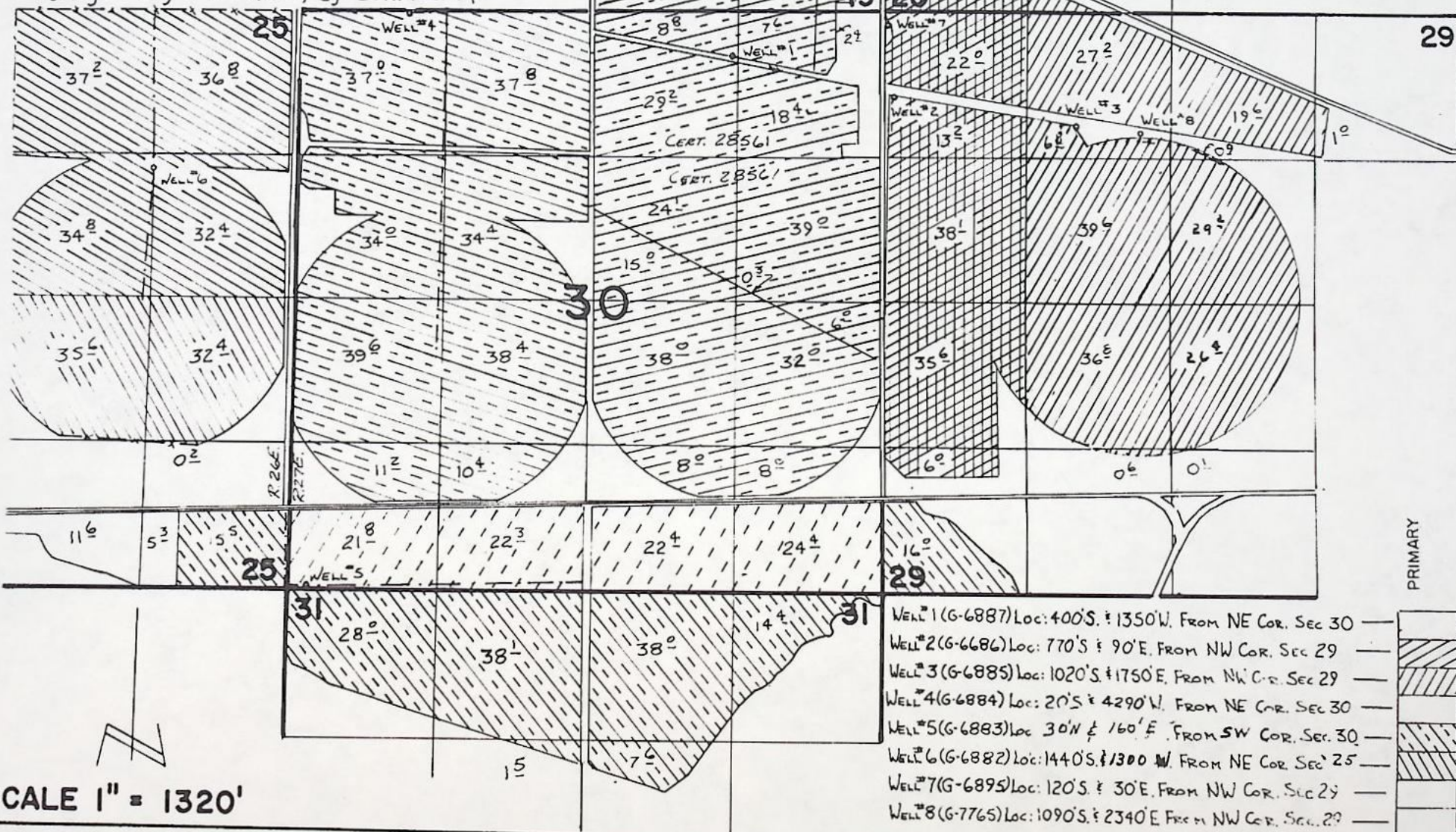

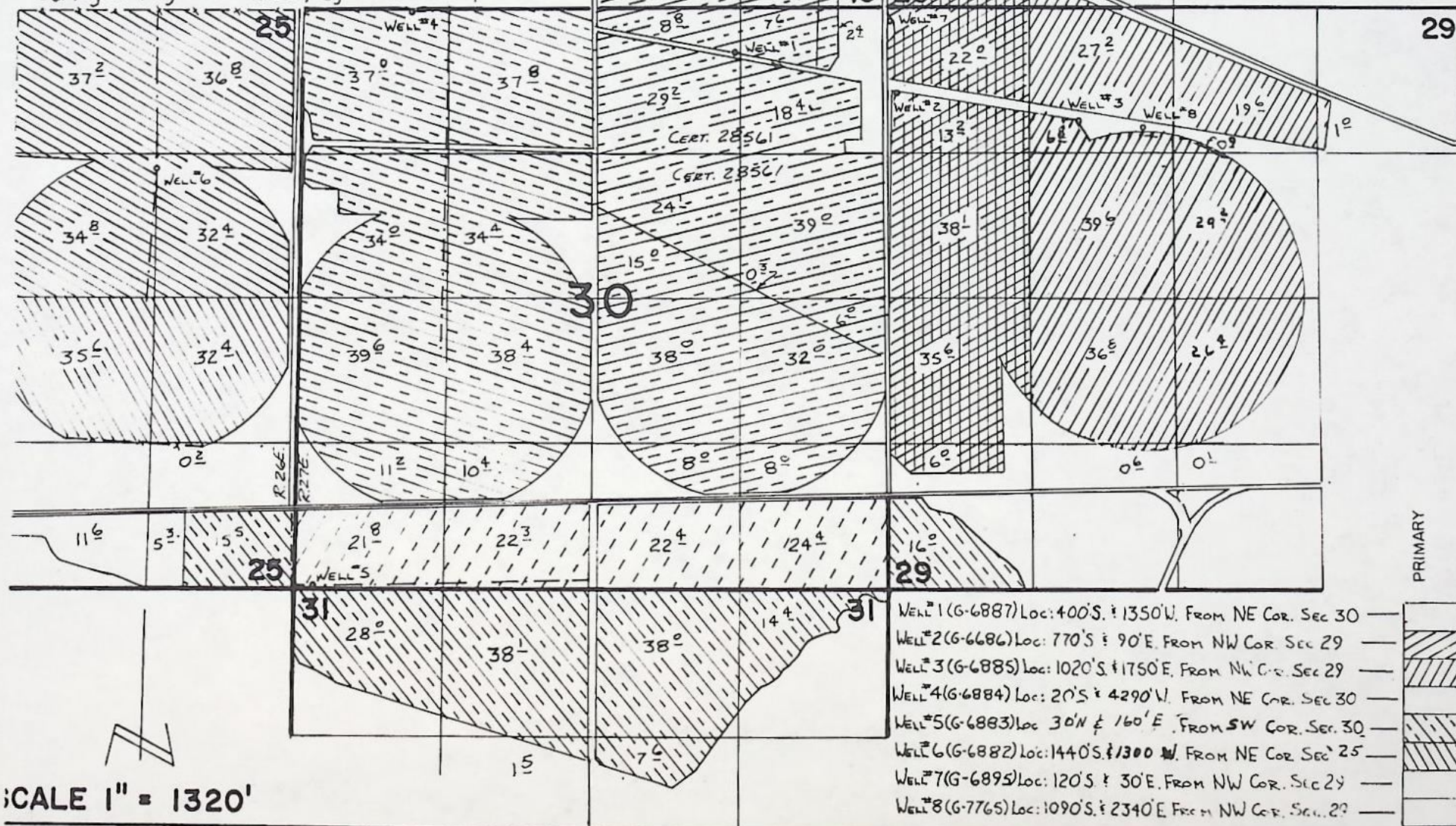

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, **SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD** and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 3.12 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the well or source of appropriation, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from well # 8

The use to which this water is to be applied is supplemental irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

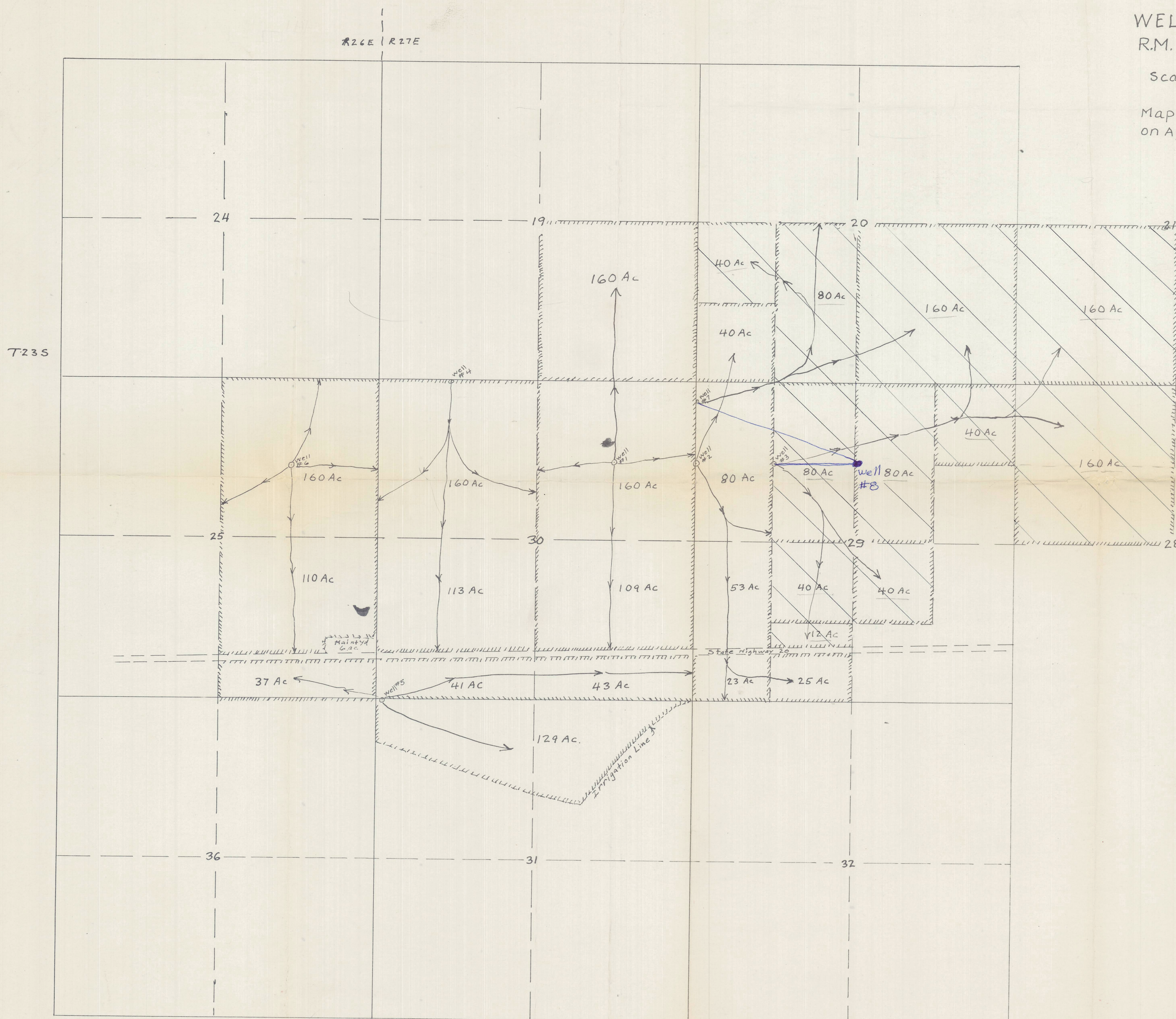
