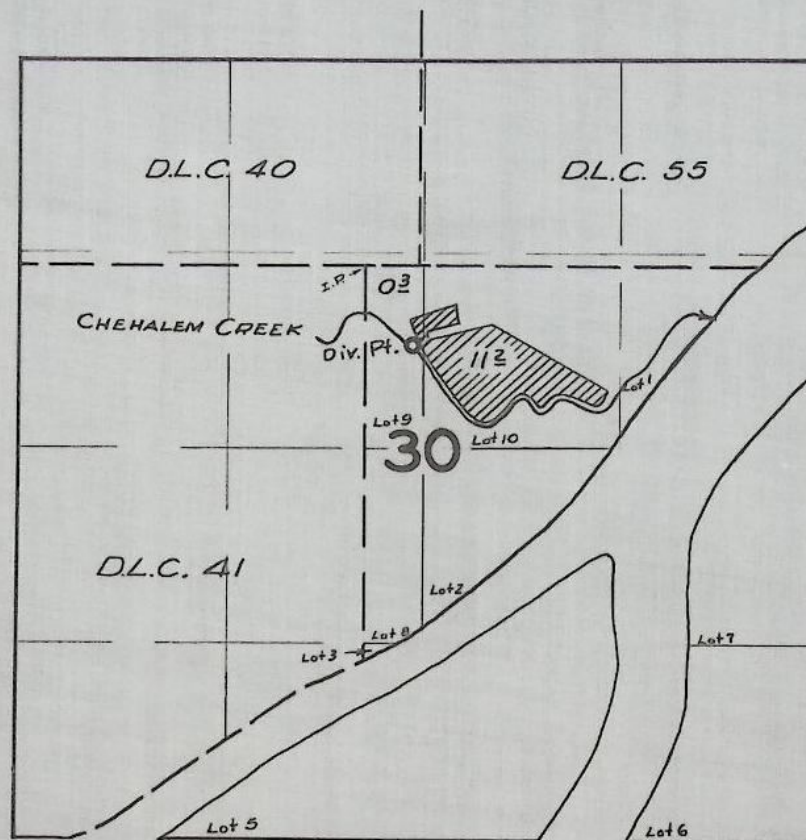

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That RUTH M. MELLINGER

of P.O. Box 224, Newberg, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Chehalen Creek a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation of 11.5 acres

under Permit No. 25583 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon, that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 17, 1958

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.14 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 9 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 30, T. 3 S., R. 2 W., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.3 acre Lot 9 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
11.2 acres Lot 10 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)

T. 3 S., R. 2 W., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

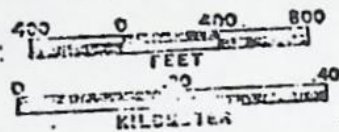

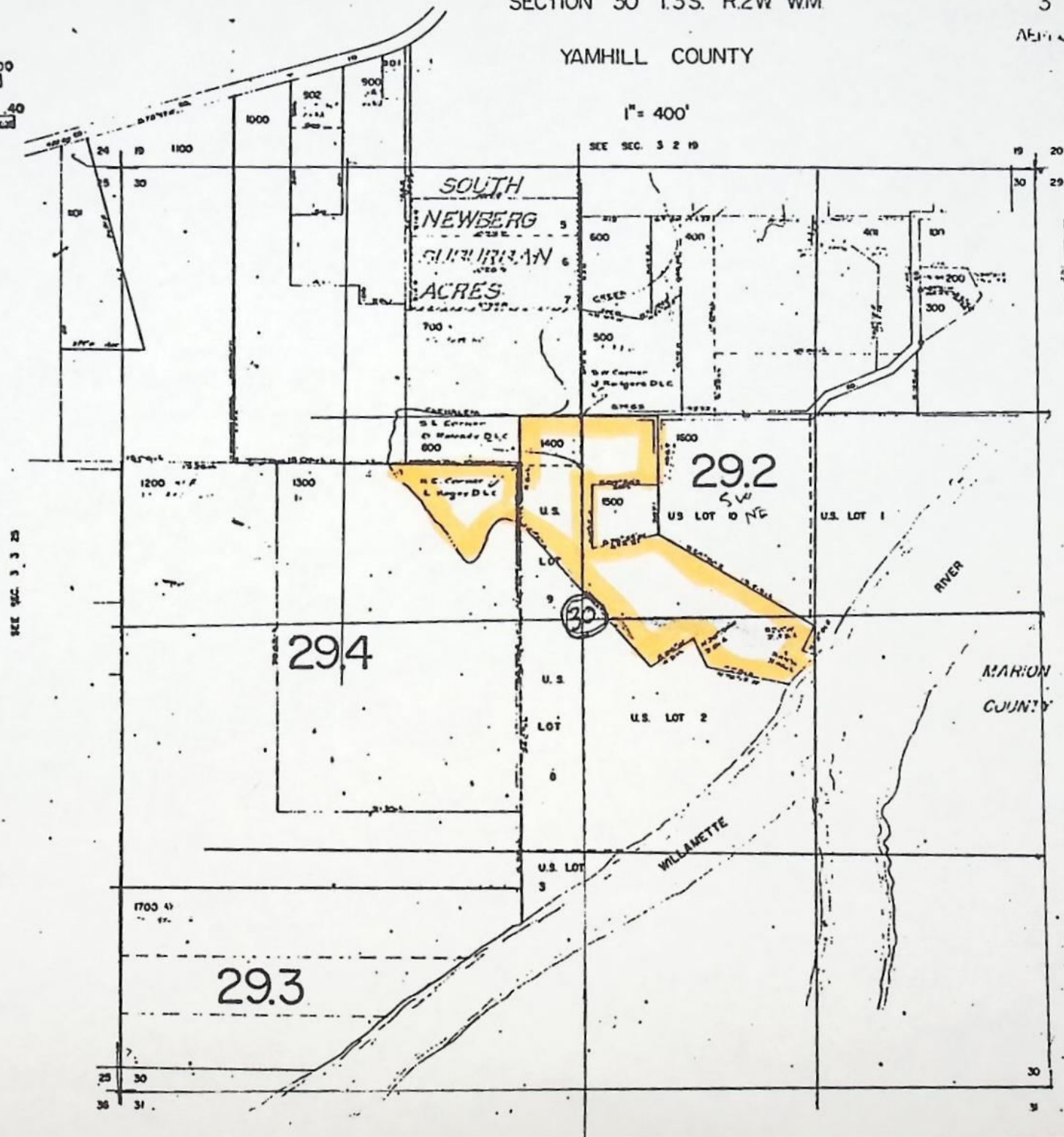

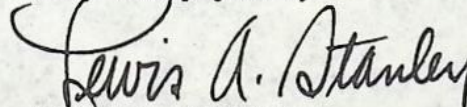
Dear Madam:

This will acknowledge receipt of your notice to the effect that complete application of water has been made under Permit No. 25563.

Pursuant to your report and in line with the general practice of this office a survey will be made at a later date. After this survey, proof may be made and certificate issued covering the actual use of water as found by the engineer. In case of irrigation, any lands described in the permit that have not been irrigated will be automatically eliminated from the water right.

In the meantime, the permit which you hold will be valid evidence of the water right in question so long as you continue to use the water.

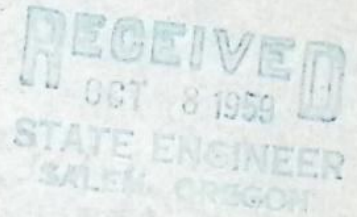

When I applied for a permit to use water from Chehalis creek, I explained that I would put the pipe in deep holes and a dam was not necessary. The land is near the mouth of the creek on the Willamette and in the winter over flows and a new earth-filled dam would have to be built every spring; a concrete structure would be too expensive.

Since the permit was issued in 1958, I have irrigated without building a dam and it is satisfactory. No one between my place and the river uses water for irrigation.
