Appeal Rights

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Application History

On February 12, 2007, Robert E. Streiff submitted an application to the Department for an extension of time for Permit S-52513. The Department issued Permit S-52513 on July 17, 1996. The permit called for completion of construction by October 1, 1997, and complete application of water to beneficial use by October 1, 1998. In accordance with OAR 690-315-0050(2), on July 24, 2007, the Department issued a Proposed Final Order proposing to extend the time to complete construction to October 1, 2010, and the time to fully apply water to beneficial use to October 1, 2010. The protest period closed September 7, 2007, in accordance with OAR 690-315-0060(1). No protest was filed.

The applicant has demonstrated good cause for the permit extension pursuant to ORS 537.230, 539.010(5) and OAR 690-315-0040(2).

Order

The extension of time for Application S-69503, Permit S-52513, therefore, is approved. The deadline for completing construction is extended to October 1, 2010. The deadline for applying water to full beneficial use is extended to October 1, 2010.
