A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL, in the DESCHUTES RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 5.34 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10624. The date of priority is JANUARY 16, 1985. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.07 cubic foot per second (if lawfully available at the original point of appropriation, being located NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 31, T 15 S, R 11 E, W.M.; 80 FEET SOUTH AND 2290 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER, SECTION 31), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 35, T 14 S, R 10 E, W.M.; 1372 FEET SOUTH AND 1446 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 35.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.



This right was perfected under Permit G-10624. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.12 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M.; 80 FEET SOUTH AND 2290 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER, SECTION 31, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4 SECTION 35, T 14 S, R 10 E, W.M.; 1372 FEET SOUTH AND 1446 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 35.
