(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That W. J. WELCH

State of

Oregon has a right to the use of

the waters of Morth Powder River, a tribatary of Powder River,

for the purpose of the irrigation of 4532 acres of land and domestic and stock use,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union

County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Flats Park Hours of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at page 252; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1879 for the irrigation of 90 acres and from 1890 for 3632 acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount uctually beneficially used for suid purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 3.75 sec. ft. from March 1st to October 1st of each year; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 1134 acre feet.


