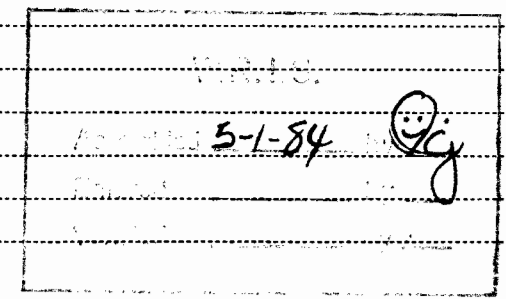

 (Reservoir or Enlargement.)

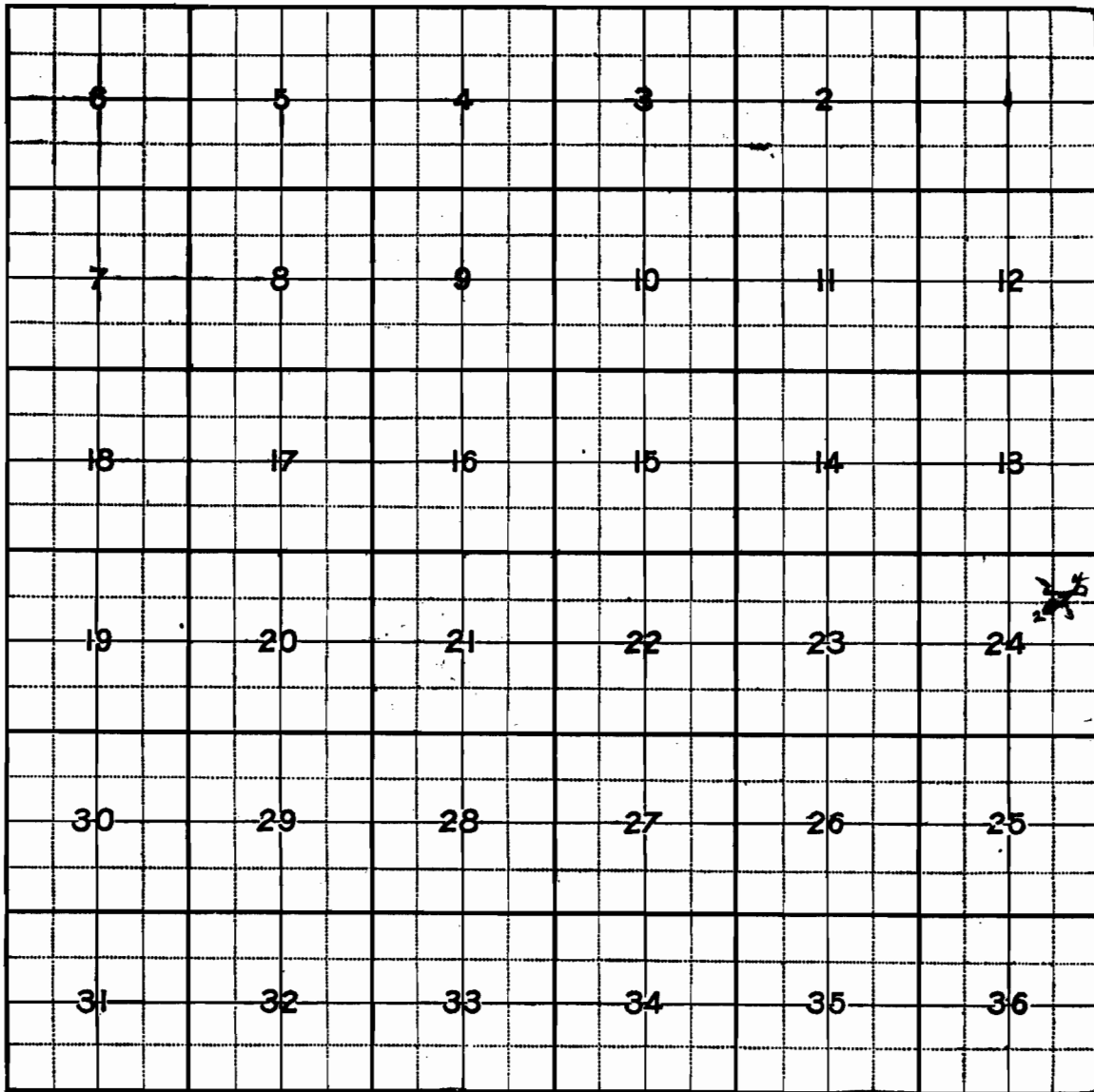

I note from the records of this office that you have not submitted final proof under your permit No. 1768, which covers the appropriation of 0.11 second foot of water from 2 small springs for domestic use and for the irrigation of 1 acre of land, although the final proof blanks were forwarded you for execution on November 21, 1916. In view of the fact that final proof has not been submitted, we presume you have abandoned this water right and if so, we would be glad to have you authorize the cancelation of the permit on the records of this office as this will eliminate the necessity of following the regular procedure for the cancelation of the same.

However, if the terms of the permit have been complied with, we would be glad to have you submit final proof in order that a final water right certificate may be issued by the Board.

As we have received no reply to our letter of July 24, 1917, in regard to this matter, you are advised that unless hearing from you within 60 days from the date of this letter the permit will be presented to the Board for cancelation in accordance with the provisions of Section 7, Chapter 366, laws of Oregon for 1917, which provides for the cancelation of permits when the holders thereof fail or refuse to complete the water right within three months after the same should have been completed.
