~~Morrow Reservoir is inside of Pine Hollow Reservoir. The same pump station is used for both. In the spring, when Pine Hollow Reservoir is full, any irrigation water pumped will be from Pine Hollow Reservoir. As the irrigation season progresses along, the water level in Pine Hollow drops. This exposes Morrow Reservoir. Now water pumped comes from water stored behind Morrow Dam. This is the supplemental use.~~
