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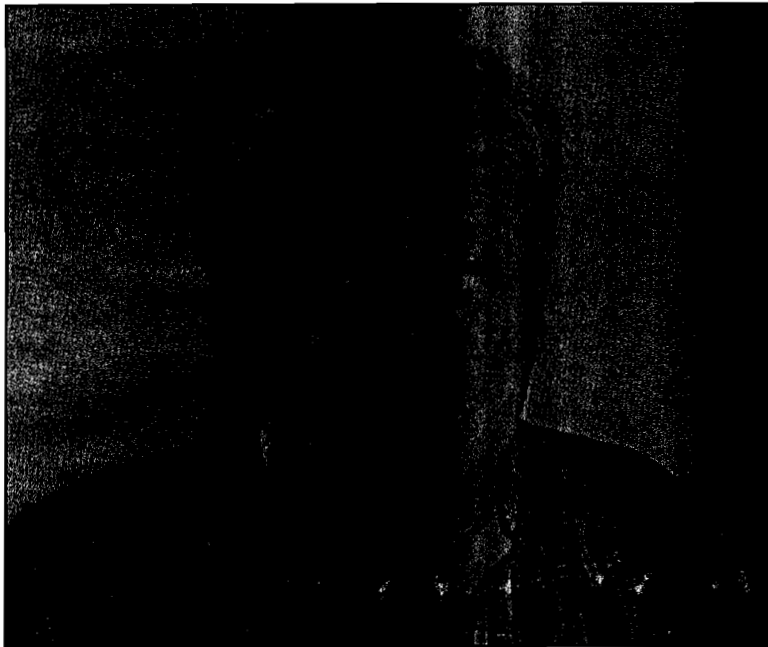

## Wayne N. McKy

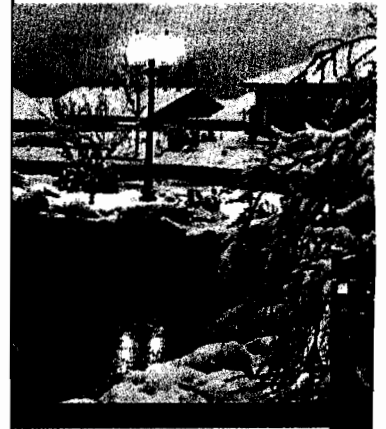


**Birthplace:** Grants Pass, Oregon.
