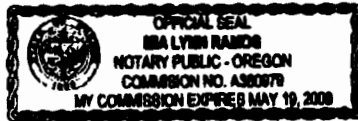

6. We agree that if this change is approved, it is permanent and the rights to the use of water from Poison Creek and Foley Slough cannot be changed back to the primary source unless otherwise provided by law. We also agree that so long as there is sufficient water available from the new primary source, we are not entitled to use any water from Poison Creek or Foley Slough for primary irrigation of these lands.
