do hereby make application for a permit to construct the reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

1. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled is unnamed drainge tributary to Willamette River

2. If not in channel of a stream, state how it is to be filled. not in channel run-off to be collected from hillside above resevoir site

3. The dam will be located in the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 29, Township 3S, Range 1W, W. M.

4. The maximum height will be 9 feet above stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 12 feet, slope of upstream face 2:1, slope of downstream face 1 1/2:1, and height of dam above water line when full 2 1/2 feet.

The right herein granted is limited to the construction of a reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed drainage to be appropriated under Application 61649, Permit 45984 for irrigation and stock, being 5.0 A-F for irrigation and 0.6 A-F for stock.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 5.6 acre feet.

The priority date of this permit is September 17, 1981

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 7, 1982 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983

Your application for a permit to construct a reservoir and store 5.6 acre-feet of water from an unnamed drainage has been filed as R-61648. Also received was the fee of \$30 for which our Receipt 23981 is enclosed.

Your application for a permit to use the water from the unnamed drainage and the reservoir for irrigation of 8.7 acres and stockwater has been filed as 61649. Received with that application was three copies of a map, legal description, and the fee of \$45 for which Receipt 23982 is enclosed.

Under Item 7 of your reservoir Application R-61648 the quantity of water to be stored for irrigation and the quantity of water to be used for stockwater should be listed with the total equal to that amount under Item 8 of the application.

Item 1 of your Application 61649 is apparently in error I believe it should be the Willamette River to which the unnamed drainage is a tributary.

Item 2 of that application list the diversion point as being within the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 29. The map shows that as being located in the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 29. The application and the map must be in complete agreement.

Item 4 of the application should request a quantity of water from direct flow so that you would be able to use any runoff that would occur during the irrigation season. The quantity of water normally allowed for your irrigation of 8.7 acres is 0.11 cubic foot per second and that allowed for stockwater is 0.005 cubic foot per second. Item 4 should list the total amount requested and Item 5 the quantity to be requested for each use.

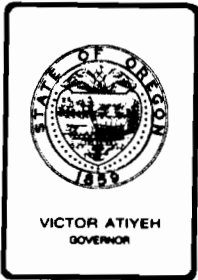

According to the terms of your Permits Numbered R-8300 and 45984 which was for 5.0 acre feet of storage of water for stock and irrigation and 0.115 cubic feet per second from an unnamed drainage and reservoir in Clackamas Co. complete application of water was to have been made by Oct. 1, 1984

Complete application of water means the application of water to a beneficial use under the permit to the full extent intended. In the case of irrigation, it means beneficial irrigation of all the lands the permittee intends to cover under the terms of the permit. If the water has been used, you should promptly submit notice describing the extent of completion as set forth in the letter accompanying your permit and also in our postal card of Oct. 18, 1984.

ORS 537.260 provides that: "Whenever the time within which any appropriation under a permit should have been perfected has expired and the owner of the permit fails or refuses within three months thereafter to submit to the Water Resources Director proof of completion of the appropriation as required by ORS 537.230 and 537.250, the Water Resources Director may, after 60 days notice by registered mail, order the cancellation of the permit..."

In accordance with the provisions of ORS 537.260, you are hereby notified that unless proof of beneficial use is received within 60 days from the date of this letter, the permit(s) may be canceled without further notice.

If for any reason, you are no longer interested in the project described by the permit, we would appreciate it if you would so advise. If the property involved has changed hands and any part of the project has been completed, you should immediately assign the permit to the new owner and advise us of his name and address. An assignment form will be furnished upon request.
