**Final Order**  
**Extension of Time for Permit Number G-12429**

**Appeal Rights**

**This is a final order in other than contested case.** This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

**Application History**


On July 25, 2001, Larry Halousek and Ty Halousek, dba Halousek Brothers submitted an application to the Department for an extension of time for permit number G-12429. The Department issued permit number G-12429 on July 31, 1996. The permit called for completion of construction by October 1, 1997, and complete application of water to beneficial use by October 1, 2000. In accordance with OAR 690-315-0050(2), on September 27, 2005, the Department issued a Proposed Final Order proposing to extend the time to fully apply water to beneficial use to October 15, 2006. The protest period closed November 11, 2005, in accordance with OAR 690-315-0060(1). No protest was filed.

At time of issuance of the Proposed Final Order the Department concluded that, based on the factors demonstrated by the applicant, the permit may be extended subject to no additional conditions.

**Order**

The extension of time for Application Number G-12777, Permit Number G-12429, therefore, is approved. The deadline for applying water to full beneficial use is extended to October 15, 2006.
