





ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. M-209

On June 23, 1969, John E. McCaige filed an application in the office of the Water Resources Director for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from John Day River pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right recorded at Page 24504, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Blue Mountain Ditch Co., describes an existing right of record which includes the use of not to exceed 3.16 cubic feet per second from John Day River for the irrigation of, among other lands, 0.5 acre in NET NWT, 37.8 acres in SWT NWT, 35.0 acres in SET NWT, 28.3 acres in NET SWT, 36.6 acres in NWT SWT, 0.9 acre in SWT SWT. Section 26; 8.1 acres in SW2 NE2, 37.4 acres in SE2 NE2, 36.9 acres in NET SET and 31.2 acres in NWT SET, Section 27, Township 13 South, Range 29 East, W.M., with a date of priority of October 23, 1916. Water is conveyed to these lands by means of the Blue Mountain Ditch from a point of diversion located 2150 feet South and 3000 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 29, being within the SW NE of Section 29, Township 13 South, Range 30 East, W.M., and, for a period of the irrigation season beginning about July 1 of each year, by means of a pump at an additional point of diversion located 690 feet South and 3360 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 26, being within the NET NWT of Section 26, Township 13 South, Range 29 East, W.M.



The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to discontinue the use of water by means of the Blue Mountain Ditch and to divert water for the irrigation of the above described lands throughout the irrigation season by means of the pump located 690 feet South and 3360 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 26, being within the NE4 NW4 of Section 26, Township 13 South, Range 29 East, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.510 was published in the Blue Mountain Eagle, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Grant County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of November 27, December 4 and 11, 1969.

Mr. Howard Daggett, Watermaster of District No. 4, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion from John Day River described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion, and shall not exceed 3.16 cubic feet per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be carried out prior to the diverting of water at the new point of diversion as herein confirmed:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that no time need be fixed for completion as the change in point of diversion is completed.

The right to appropriate 0.19 cubic foot per second of water for the irrigation of 14.8 acres was canceled by an order of the State Engineer entered November 18, 1963. This order canceled the certificate recorded at Page 24504, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and provided for issuance of a new certificate for the remainder of the right not canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the portion of the right involved in the change authorized herein NOT be included in the new certificate to be issued as provided by the said order entered November 18, 1963, and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of the change in point of diversion authorized herein, a certificate of water right shall be issued to John E. McCaige confirming the change in point of diversion.



Jerry, your memo of July 13, 1979 regarding permit No. 3163 involved the confirming certificate 48136 under transfer M-209 as regards the placement of the same 252.7 acres previously listed under certificate 46261. You felt that we should not have it listed on both certificates, however, if you will inspect the transfers involved M-209 and C-137, you will find that certificate 48136 allows a 252.7 acres to be diverted from the pumping diversion point during the early season, April 1 to about July 1 of each year. Certificate 46261 allowed the use of the Blue Mountain Ditch for those lands in the early season and the pumping diversion afterwards, however, this was not specifically defined but was on the certificate by reference to the transfer entered December 13, 1961, which in essence relates to transfer C-137. I believe that if we had really been on our toes we could have made this more clear in the certificates, however, it is there by reference and the land should be listed on both certificates to allow the use of the pumping diversion point throughout the season.

Thanks for the response and a copy of this memo will go in both files so that should this come up again, it will be made clear.


