Dear Sir:

Your application for permit to appropriate water from a well for irrigation of 34 acres has been filed as No. U-41. Please find enclosed my receipt No. 12771 covering your remittance of \$10.10 as fees for this application.

With the exception that the application and map do not indicate clearly the number of acres to be irrigated in each legal 40 acre subdivision, the application is considered in satisfactory form. I am returning it to you so that these areas may be given. They should be written in on the map and tabulated under Paragraph 11 of the application. I presume it will be necessary for you to attach a separate sheet as you have already used up all the space there was under Paragraph 11. The map would indicate that there probably is about 30 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5 and 4 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4. It is not necessary to refer to the lots and blocks in the Villa Park Addition to Ontario.

If resubmitted to this office on or before November 8th, the application will retain its original priority.
