We are requesting that the following edits be made to the applications:

- 1) #6 on page 2 of the reservoir application: Change uses to read "Multipurpose including..."

- 3) The surface water point of diversion for the unnamed intermittent stream will be the same as the Fern Creek Reservoir point of diversion.
