We have also requested appropriation of water from the unnamed stream for irrigation and reservoir maintenance for your consideration since the cancelled certificate applied to that source.

In addition, we have applied for the stored water on the adjacent properties to the east and west of the subject property for supplemental coverage. I believe I have handled this in the manner we discussed.

The right has been perfected under Permit 44869. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 4, 1979. The right is limited to not more than 8.0 ACRE FEET STORED WATER ONLY FOR IRRIGATION AND 700 GALLONS PER DAY FROM STREAM AND RESERVOIR FOR STOCK USE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.
