Dear Sir:-

As the post office of Alberson is discontinued on April 1st, kindly address me at Andrews.

The enclosed "Application for Permit to Appropriate Water" granted to Erland Carlson was handed me to see if it could be transferred.

The desert claim to which it applies was abandoned by Erland Carlson, and filed on by William Marie Bruckwilder on November 11, 1913.

He at once put in a dam and dug a quarter mile of ditch. The dam has since been washed out by a cloudburst. Mr. Bruckwilder would of course like to save the date of priority if he could; if not, at least save the cost of taking out a new permit.

I could see no way of accomplishing either purpose, since actual construction shall begin on or before April 18, 1911, whereas it did not begin for over two years thereafter; and as I understand it, this is one provision which cannot be extended. Kindly write me if I am correct, and if not, how to proceed.

APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF OREGON

I, Eelard Carlson (Name of Applicant) of Andrus, Oregon (Postoffice), County of Harney

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.
