Dear Mr. Cohn:

Enclosed is a certified copy of the State Engineer's order canceling a certain water right evidenced by certificates issued in the name of Bridal Veil Lumbering Company and recorded at pages 454, 455, 458, 466 and 481, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, which were recorded in your office on or about August 31, 1914.

Under the provisions of ORS 540.650, the County Clerk shall stamp or write across the face of the recorded water right certificate which evidences the right the words: "Canceled by order of the State Engineer, dated December 10, 1965."

The right for power under Certificate 480 expired under the provisions of the 40 year limitation and as such was not canceled.
