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Please place a requirement on this transfer that a cumulative use measurement device be installed prior to use. A start number on the measurement device and monthly use statements need to be mailed to District 21 Watermaster's office. Reporting water use will assist in regulating the maximum water available for use for the season.

Maximum use: 36 acre feet = 1,568,160 cubic feet = 11,730,651.4 US gallons
