STIPULATION TO RESOLVE CONTESTS

Claimants/Contestants, G Bar W Land and Cattle Company, Richard Sanford, Jennifer Sanford, Jeff Hunt and Lynda Hunt, Contestants, the United States of America (the "United States"), the Klamath Tribes (the "Tribes"), and the Klamath Project Water Users ("KPWU"), ¹

The group of Contestants herein known as the "Klamath Project Water Users" currently includes the following Contestants: Tulelake Irrigation District, Klamath Irrigation District,

and the Oregon Water Resources Department ("OWRD"), hereby agree and stipulate, and request the Adjudicator to resolve the above-captioned claim and contests as follows:

A. STIPULATED FACTS

- 1. On November 19, 1990, Diane Taylor, Manager of the Dennis Ranch, filed this Claim No. 12 in the Klamath Adjudication. In 1993, the land subject to this claim was sold to the G Bar W Land and Cattle Company. OWRD Exhibit 1 at 41-42. In 1999, the G Bar W Land and Cattle Company sold 320 acres of the claimed lands (in undivided interest) to Richard Sanford, Jennifer Sanford, Jeff Hunt and Lynda Hunt. OWRD Exhibit 1 at 66, 69-70.
- 2. On October 4, 1999, the Adjudicator issued his Preliminary Evaluation of Claim 12, preliminarily approving the claim for a smaller quantity of water than was claimed.
- 3. The following contests were filed to Claim 12: Contest 29, filed by Jeff Hunt; Contest 1786, filed by Steve and James Lawrence; Contest 1789, filed by G Bar W Land and Cattle Company; and Contest 2817, filed by WaterWatch of Oregon; Contest 3434, filed by KPWU; Contest 3718, filed by the United States; and Contest 4074, filed by the Tribes. No other contests were filed to Claim 12 or the Preliminary Evaluation of the claim.

Klamath Drainage District, Klamath Basin Improvement District, Ady District Improvement Company, Enterprise Irrigation District, Malin Irrigation District, Midland District Improvement Company, Pine Grove Irrigation District, Pioneer District Improvement Company, Poe Valley Improvement District, Shasta View Irrigation District, Sunnyside Irrigation District, Don Johnston & Son, Bradley S. Luscombe, Randy Walthall, Inter-County Title Co., Winema Hunting Lodge, Inc., Van Brimmer Ditch Co., Plevna District Improvement Company, and Collins Products, LLC. This group of Contestants formerly included Don Vincent, Berlva Pritchard and Klamath Hills District Improvement Co., however, Don Vincent withdrew his contest on December 4, 2000, Berlva Pritchard withdrew her contest on June 24, 2002, and Klamath Hills District Improvement Co. withdrew its contest on January 16, 2004.

- 4. On February 25, 2003, Contest 1786 was withdrawn by Steve and James Lawrence. On July 14, 2003, Contest 1789 was withdrawn by the G Bar W Land and Cattle Company. On February 20, 2003, Contest 2813 was withdrawn by WaterWatch of Oregon.
- 5. The only remaining Contests to Claim 12 are: Contest 29, filed by Jeff Hunt; Contest 3434, filed by KPWU; Contest 3718, filed by the United States; and Contest 4074, filed by the Tribes.
- 6. Claimants/Contestants, G Bar W Land and Cattle Company, Richard Sanford, Jennifer Sanford, Jeff Hunt and Lynda Hunt, Contestants, KPWU, the United States and the Tribes, and OWRD agree that Contests 29, 3434, 3718 and 4074 can be resolved without the need for a hearing pursuant to the terms set forth below.

B. TERMS OF STIPULATION

- 1. Claimants/Contestants, G Bar W Land and Cattle Company, Richard Sanford, Jennifer Sanford, Jeff Hunt and Lynda Hunt, Contestants, the United States, the Klamath Tribes and KPWU, and OWRD agree that Claim 12 should be approved by the Adjudicator to the extent described below. Claimants/Contestants, Contestants and OWRD agree that Claim 12 should be approved as follows:
 - (a) Right to be adjudicated to Claimant G Bar W Land and Cattle Company: Point of Diversion No. 1:
 - (1) POINT OF DIVERSION LOCATION: SE1/4SW1/4, Section 24, Township 30 South, Range 11 East, W.M.
 - (2) SOURCE: Irving Creek, tributary to Williamson River
 - (3) USE: irrigation of 144.2 acres

- (4) AMOUNT ACTUALLY BENEFICIALLY USED: 3.58 cubic feet per second, measured at the point of diversion.
- (5) PERIOD OF USE: April 1 October 31 for irrigation; January 1 December 31 for livestock
- (6) PRIORITY DATE: October 14, 1864
- (7) PLACE OF USE:

AMOUNT ACTUALLY BENEFICIALLY USED FOR LIVESTOCK: 2400 gallons per day from all sources, measured at the point of diversion. Livestock drink directly from ditches located within the above-described places of use.

- 2. Claimants, Contestants and OWRD agree that pursuant to the terms of this Stipulation, Contests 29, 3434, 3718 and 4074 have been satisfactorily resolved, and such resolution vitiates the need for a hearing before the Administrative Law Judge on these contests to Claim 12.
- 3. Based on the agreement of Claimants, Contestants and OWRD that Claim 12 and the contests thereto can be resolved without the need for a hearing, OWRD adjudication staff hereby recommends to the Adjudicator that Claim 12 be withdrawn from the Office of Administrative Hearings. OWRD adjudication staff further recommends that Claim 12 be approved in the Finding of Fact and Order of Determination issued by the Adjudicator in accordance with the terms of paragraph B.1., above.
- 4. If the Finding of Fact and Order of Determination issued by the Adjudicator for Claim 12 does not conform to the terms set forth in paragraph B.1., above, Claimants and Contestants reserve any rights they may have to file exceptions to the Finding of Fact and Order of Determination as to Claim 12 in the Circuit Court for Klamath County, and reserve any rights they may have to participate in any future proceedings authorized by law concerning Claim 163.
- 5. This Stipulation is entered into for the purpose of resolving a disputed claim. The signatories to this Stipulation agree that the Stipulation shall not be offered as evidence or treated CASE 163 - STIPULATION TO RESOLVE CONTESTS

as an admission regarding any matter herein and may not be used in proceedings on any other claim or contest whatsoever, except that the Stipulation may be used in any future proceeding to interpret and/or enforce the terms of this Stipulation. Further, the signatories to this Stipulation agree that neither the Stipulation nor any of its terms shall be used to establish precedent with respect to any other claim or contest in the Klamath Basin Water Rights Adjudication.

6. This Stipulation may be executed in any number of counterparts, any and all of which may contain the signatures of less than all of the parties, and all of which shall be construed together as but a single instrument.
