Dwight Mebane voluntarily withdrew from Contest 2454 on June 25, 2004. Ambrose McAuliffe, William Nicholson, and Elmore Nicholson voluntarily withdrew from Contest 2754 on November 3, 2004. On November 3, 2004, Roger Nicholson substituted for Richard Nicholson in Contest 2754. Roger Nicholson voluntarily withdrew Contest 2754 on March 14, 2006. *See* Notice of Withdrawal of Contest 2754.

Don Vincent voluntarily withdrew from Contest 3458 on December 4, 2000. Berlva Pritchard voluntarily withdrew from Contest 3458 on June 24, 2002. Klamath Hills District Improvement Company voluntarily withdrew from Contest 3458 on January 15, 2004. The remaining entities of Klamath Project Water Users voluntarily withdrew from Contest 3458 on June 9, 2005. *See* Notice of Withdrawal of Contest No. 3457 (dated June 9, 2005) and Corrected Notice of Withdrawal of Contest No. 3458 (dated June 14, 2005).

The Klamath Tribes voluntarily withdrew Contest 4113 on July 16, 2004. *See* Klamath Tribes' Voluntary Withdrawal of Contest.

INTRODUCTION

Claimant/Contestant JELD-WEN, inc. ("JELD-WEN") ("Claimant") and Contestant the United States of America (the "United States") (collectively, the "Parties"), and the Oregon Water Resources Department ("OWRD"), agree and stipulate as follows:

A. STIPULATED FACTS

- 1. On February 1, 1991, JELD-WEN filed Claim 60 with OWRD. The claimed place of use for Claim 60 is certain real property located in portions of Township 34 South, Sections 12 and 13, Range 7.5 East of the Willamette Meridian ("W.M."). These lands were formerly part of the Klamath Reservation and were formerly owned by Klamath Indians or by the Klamath Tribes.
- 2. On October 4, 1999, OWRD issued its Preliminary Evaluation of Claim 60, preliminarily denying this claim.
- 3. The following contests were filed to Claim 60: Contest 2042, filed by JELD-WEN; Contest 3458, filed by entities comprising the Klamath Project Water Users ("KPWU"); Contest 3800, filed by the United States; Contest 4113, filed by the Klamath Tribes; and Contest 2754, filed by Ambrose McAullife, William Nicholson, Elmore Nicholson, Dwight Mebane and Richard Nicholson. Dwight Mebane withdrew from Contest 2754 on June 25, 2004. Ambrose McAuliffe, William Nicholson and Elmore Nicholson withdrew from Contest 2754 on November 3, 2004. Roger Nicholson substituted for Richard Nicholson in Contest 2754 on November 3, 2004. Roger Nicholson voluntarily withdrew Contest 2754 on March 14, 2006. On July 16, 2004, the Klamath Tribes voluntarily withdrew Contest 4113. The KPWU voluntarily withdrew from Contest 3458 on June 9, 2005. Contests 2042 and 3800 are collectively referenced hereinafter as the "Contests."

Page 2 - STIPULATION TO RESOLVE CONTESTS, KBA CASE 192, CLAIM 60

4. The Parties agree the Contests can be resolved without the need for further proceedings, pursuant to the terms below.

B. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The Parties and the OWRD agree that Claim 60 should be approved by the Adjudicator as described below:
 - a. **SOURCE**: Crooked Creek, tributary to the Wood River
 - b. LOCATION OF POINTS OF DIVERSION: A pump located in the NW/4SE/4 of Section 13, Township 34 South, Range 7.5 East, at a point 1420 feet north and 2210 feet west from the SE corner of said Section 13. The approximate location of the pump is shown on the map included in OWRD Exhibit 1 at page 41, a true and correct copy of which map is attached hereto at Exhibit A.
 - c. USE: Irrigation of 14.8 acres and livestock watering of 60 head of cattle
 - d. DIVERSION RATE FOR IRRIGATION: 0.37 cubic feet per second (cfs)
 (14.8 acres x 1/40 cfs per acre)
 - e. **DUTY FOR IRRIGATION**: 3.5 acre-feet/acre
 - f. ADDITIONAL DIVERSION RATE/DUTY FOR LIVESTOCK

 WATERING: 720 gallons per day (gpd) (12 gpd per head of cattle x 60 head), with livestock stock drinking directly from the above-described source (Crooked Creek) as it crosses the place of use and the ditches, canals, and laterals currently located on the place of use
 - g. **PERIOD OF USE**: May 1 through October 1 for irrigation and livestock watering
 - h. **PRIORITY DATE**: October 14, 1864
 - i. PLACE OF USE FOR IRRIGATION AND LIVESTOCK WATERING:

Township 34 South, Range 7.5 East, W.M.

Section 12: SW/4SE/4 (0.2 acres)

Section 13: NW/4NE/4 (7.5 acres), NE/4NE/4 (2.6 acres), SW/4NE/4 (1.5 acres), SE/4NE/4 (3.0 acres)

14.8 acres total

The 14.8 acres are shown more particularly on the map attached hereto as Exhibit B (the "Claim Map") at the location of the 14.8 acres identified by cross-hatching as "LAND PREVIOUSLY ADJUDICATED BY WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT." The Claim Map was also included in OWRD Exhibit 1 at page 40.

j. PLACE OF USE FOR LIVESTOCK WATERING ONLY:

Township 34 South, Range 7.5 East, W.M.

Section 13: N/2SE/4 (portions)

These lands are limited to those lands in the N/2SE/4 of Section 13, T. 34 S., R. 7.5 E., W.M., that are included in the legal description set forth in the deed attached hereto as Exhibit C (the "Livestock Watering Lands"). (This deed was also included in OWRD Exhibit 1 at pages 12-13). For purposes of this stipulation, the exterior boundaries of the Livestock Watering Lands shall be in the approximate location shown on the Claim Map.

2. The Parties and the OWRD agree that Claimant shall maintain a privilege (the "Use Privilege") to water its livestock and accept any natural sub-irrigation or natural overflow received by approximately 30.8 acres on the following lands (the "Sub-Irrigated Lands"):

Township 34 South, Range 7.5 East, W.M.

Section 12: SWSE (17.5 acres), NWSE (7.8 acres)

Page 4 - STIPULATION TO RESOLVE CONTESTS, KBA CASE 192, CLAIM 60

Section 13: NENE (3.9 acres), NWNE (0.8 acres), NWNE (0.3 acres) SENE (0.5 acres)

The Sub-Irrigated Lands are shown more particularly on the Claim Map at the location of the 30.8 acres identified by cross-hatching as "LOWLANDS – NATURAL GRASS AND WILLOWS." The Parties agree as follows with respect to the Use Privilege:

- a. The Use Privilege does not constitute a water right and cannot be asserted to curtail other water rights through the priority system.
- b. The Use Privilege may not be transferred to a new Place of Use, either permanently or temporarily.
- c. The Use Privilege cannot be exercised to modify by physical means the manner in which any natural sub-irrigation and/or natural overflow occurs, to contain or further distribute water, or to increase in any other way the consumption which takes place from the natural sub-irrigation and/or natural overflow, and that any such alteration shall require the filing of an application for permit to appropriate waters from the OWRD, the priority date of which shall be in accordance with ORS 537.150(2) or any successor statute.
- d. The Use Privilege shall not modify any rights that Claimant may have to allow its livestock to drink directly from any natural sources located on the Sub-Irrigated Lands (including Crooked Creek) under Oregon law without a certificated water right, both during the irrigation season and outside the irrigation season. In addition, the Parties agree that nothing in this stipulation is intended to preclude livestock watering from occurring pursuant to ORS 537.141(2).
- 3. The Parties and OWRD agree that under the terms and provisions of this Stipulation, the Contests have been satisfactorily resolved, and such resolution ends the need for further proceedings before the Administrative Law Judge on the Contests.

Page 5 - STIPULATION TO RESOLVE CONTESTS, KBA CASE 192, CLAIM 60

- 4. Based on the Stipulation of the Parties that Claim 60 and the Contests can be resolved without the need for further proceedings, OWRD adjudication staff hereby recommends to the Adjudicator that Claim 60 be withdrawn from the Office of Administrative Hearings. OWRD adjudication staff further recommends that Claim 60 be approved in the Finding of Fact and Order of Determination issued by the Adjudicator in accordance with the terms of paragraphs B.1 and B.2 above.
- 5. If the Finding of Fact and Order of Determination issued by the Adjudicator for Claim 60 does not conform with the terms set forth in paragraphs B.1 and B.2, above, the Parties reserve any rights they may have to file exceptions to the Finding of Fact and Order of Determination as to Claim 60 with the Adjudicator or in the courts, and otherwise reserve any rights they may have to participate in any further proceedings authorized by law concerning Claim 60.
- 6. The Parties and OWRD agree that this Stipulation has been reached through good faith negotiations for the purpose of resolving legal disputes, including pending administrative action. The Parties and OWRD agree that no offers and/or compromises made in the course of negotiations shall be construed as admissions against interest. The Parties and OWRD agree that this Stipulation shall not be offered as evidence or treated as an admission regarding any matter and may not be used in proceedings on any other claim or contest whatsoever, except that this Stipulation may be used in any future proceeding to interpret and/or enforce the terms of this Stipulation. Further, the Parties and OWRD agree that neither the Stipulation nor any of its terms shall be used to establish precedent with respect to any other claim or contest in the Klamath Basin Water Rights Adjudication.
- 7. This Stipulation shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the Parties and OWRD and their respective heirs, executors, administrators, trustees, beneficiaries, predecessors, successors, affiliated and related entities, officers, directors,

principals, agents, employees, assigns, representatives, and all persons, firms, associations, and/or corporations connected with them.

- 8. Each signatory to this Stipulation represents, warrants, and agrees that the person who executed this Stipulation on its behalf has the full right and authority to enter into this Stipulation on behalf of that signatory and bind that signatory to the terms of the Stipulation.
- 9. The terms, provisions, conditions, and covenants of this Stipulation are not severable; however, if any term, provision, condition, or covenant of this Stipulation is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, void, or unenforceable, the remainder of the terms, provisions, conditions, and covenants shall remain in full force and effect, and shall in no way be affected, impaired, or invalidated.
- 10. The Stipulation may be executed in several counterparts. All documents so executed shall constitute one Stipulation, binding on the signatories, notwithstanding that the signatories did not sign the same original or the same counterparts. Delivery of an executed signature page to this Stipulation by facsimile transmission shall be as effective as delivery of an original signed counterpart of this Stipulation.
- 11. This Stipulation comprises the entire agreement, and no promise, inducement, or representation other than herein set forth has been made, offered, and/or agreed upon, and the terms of this Stipulation are contractual and not merely a recital.
- 12. In settling their contests, Contestants do not waive any issue or argument regarding the administration of any water right granted to them in this adjudication.
 - 13. The Parties and OWRD agree to each bear their own costs and attorneys' fees.
 - 14. This Stipulation shall be effective as of the date of the last signature hereto. STIPULATED, AGREED, AND APPROVED BY:





