Claimant John S. Kronenberger (Claimant), Contestant United States of America (Contestant), collectively referred to as the ("Parties")<sup>1</sup>, and the Oregon Water Resources Department ("OWRD"), stipulate and agree as follows.

#### A. STIPULATED FACTS

- 1. On November 14, 1990, Claimant's predecessors Russell and Edith Walsh filed Claim No. 103 within the Klamath Basin Adjudication for a *Walton* water right with a priority of October 14, 1864, for a total rate of 6.0 cubic feet per second from a point of diversion located on the Sycan River, for irrigation of 240.0 acres, and for a season of use of April 15 through September 30.
  - 2. The United States timely filed a contest to Claim No. 103, Contest No. 3809. The

WATERWATCH OF OREGON, INC.'S CONTESTS, May 20, 2003. Don Vincent voluntarily withdrew from Contest 3483 (contest of Klamath Project Water Users) on June 24, 2002. On April 8, 2004, the remaining entities comprising the Klamath Project Water users voluntarily withdrew contest 3483. The Klamath Tribes withdrew Contest 4137 on March 4, 2005.

Klamath Tribes and the Klamath Project Water Users also filed contests against the claim (nos. 4137 and 3483, respectively), subsequently withdrawn, and Water Watch of Oregon Inc., filed a contest against the claim (contest no. 2842), subsequently dismissed.

- 3. Claimant, Contestant, and OWRD agree that pursuant to the terms set forth below in Section B of this Stipulation, Contest No. 3809 can be resolved without the need for further proceedings before the Administrative Law Judge.
- 4. The Parties stipulate for purposes of resolving Claim No.103 that the acres described in Section B of this Stipulation were developed in a sufficiently timely manner after transfer out of Indian ownership and continuously used in order to qualify for a *Walton* right.
- 5. The Parties also stipulate for purposes of resolving Claim No. 103 that the remaining acres do not qualify for a *Walton* right.

#### **B. TERMS AND PROVISIONS**

Claimant, Contestant, and OWRD agree that Claim No. 103 should be approved by the Adjudicator as described below:

The place of use for Claim No. 103 is shown more particularly on the maps attached hereto as Exhibits A and B, and incorporated by reference herein. The map at Exhibit A, the claim map, depicts the 55.4 acres of irrigated lands in the place of use in the NW ¼ NW ¼ and the SW ¼ NW ¼ of Section 34, Township 35 South, Range 12 East. In addition, the map at Exhibit B, 2005 map, depicts the 16.0 irrigated acres in the place of use in the SE ¼ SE ¼ of Section 28, Township 35 South, Range 12 East, Willamette Meridian. The remaining acres shown on Exhibit A are not in the Claim No. 103 place of use.

The point of diversion for Claim No. 103 is shown on Exhibit A as: "Existing Diversion Point on East Bank of [Sycan] River 800' West and 25' North of Section Corner," which is located in the SE ½ SE ½, Section 28, Township 35 South, Range 12 East, Willamette Meridian. The remaining points of diversion shown on Exhibit A are not points of diversion for Claim No. 103.

#### C. RESOLUTION BASED ON TERMS OF STIPULATION

- 1. The Parties agree that, pursuant to this Stipulation, Claim No. 103 and the Contest thereto have been satisfactorily resolved by this Stipulation and such resolution vitiates the need for a hearing on Claim No. 103 before the Office of Administrative Hearings.
- OWRD Adjudication staff hereby recommends to the Adjudicator that Claim No.
   be withdrawn from further consideration by the Office of Administrative Hearings and that
   Claim No. 103 be approved in the Findings of Fact and Order of Determination issued by the

Adjudicator in accordance with the terms of Section B of this Stipulation, above.

- 3. If the Findings of Fact and Order of Determination issued by the Adjudicator for Claim No. 103 do not accord with the terms set forth in Section B of this Stipulation, above, Claimant and Contestant, respectively, each reserves any right each may have to file exceptions to the Findings of Fact and Final Order of Determination as to Claim No. 103 in the Circuit Court for Klamath County, and reserves any rights each may have to participate in any future proceedings authorized by law.
- 4. The Parties agree not to oppose or object to Section B of this Stipulation or any of its terms, provisions, conditions, or covenants and to support Section B of this Stipulation if it is challenged in the administrative or judicial phases of the Adjudication or any appeals thereof.
- 5. This Stipulation is entered into for the purpose of resolving a disputed claim. The Parties and OWRD agree that the Stipulation shall not be offered as evidence or treated as an admission regarding any matter herein and may not be used in proceedings on any other claim or contest whatsoever, except that the Stipulation may be used in any future proceeding to interpret and/or enforce the terms of this Stipulation. Further, the Parties and OWRD agree that neither the Stipulation nor any of its terms shall be used to establish precedent with respect to any other claim or contest in the Klamath Basin Adjudication.
- 6. This Stipulation shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the Parties and their respective heirs, executors, administrators, trustors, trustees, beneficiaries, predecessors, successors, affiliated and related entities, officers, directors, principals, agents, employees, assigns, representatives and all persons, firms, associations, and/or corporations connected with them.
- 7. Each entity or person entering into this Stipulation represents, warrants, and agrees that the person who executed this Stipulation on its behalf has the full right and authority to enter into this Stipulation on behalf of that entity or person and bind that entity or person to the terms of the Stipulation.

- 8. The terms, provisions, conditions, and covenants of this Stipulation are not severable, except, if any term, provision, condition, or covenant of this Stipulation is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, void, or unenforceable, the remainder of the terms, provisions, conditions, and covenants shall remain in full force and effect and shall in no way be affected, impaired, or invalidated.
- 9. This Stipulation may be executed in several counterparts and all documents so executed shall constitute one Stipulation, binding on the Parties notwithstanding that the Parties did not sign the same original or the same counterparts. Delivery of an executed signature page to this Stipulation by facsimile transmission shall be as effective as delivery of an original signed counterpart of this Stipulation.
- 10. The Parties agree and acknowledge that this Stipulation has been drafted and reviewed through joint efforts of their respective legal counsel after full and arms-length negotiations; therefore, the usual rule of contractual construction that all ambiguities shall be construed against the drafting party shall not apply to the interpretation of the Stipulation.
- 11. This Stipulation comprises the entire agreement and no promise, inducement, or representation other than herein set forth has been made, offered, and/or agreed upon, and the terms of this Stipulation are contractual and not merely a recital.
  - 12. The Parties and OWRD shall each bear their own costs in this proceeding.
  - 13. This Stipulation shall be effective as of the date of the last signature hereto.


