



Concerning the vesters water right filed for by William L. or Cora L. Fummerton on May 31, 1990, SWR #13, I would like to point out some facts as I have observed them. Under the "Purposes For Which Water Is Used" on the "Registration Statement Claiming A Right To Appropriate Surface Water", irrigation has not happened on this property, other than yard and garden, for any of the last ten years that I can remember.

Furthermore, in the last 36 years I've lived here, I've never seen irrigation in all the places designated on the proposed map. Only as a child did I see some sporadic watering of a small half-acre of pasture.

As I see it, this is just a continuation of a generations' old family water fight. This time a ply to try and take away irrigation rights of Robert Hall from further up the creek.

In all fairness, a hearing should be held and all facts from interested parties be presented.

The original irrigated garden area on the conal side of the creek I have never seen irrigated from their indicated point of diversion)



I, ELMER JACKSON MELTON, being first duly sworn, depose and say:

That I make this Affidavit in support of the application for water rights, made by WILLIAM L. FUMMERTON and CORA LEE FUMMERTON and for the purposes of supplying the facts and history regarding the use of the water on Melton Creek.

I have lived on the land in question for 87 years, since 1900. This property is located on Melton Road and Melton Creek flows through the property. My parents lived on the property in question since 1885 and owned the original 40 acres in question generally known as the West half of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 12, Township 28S, R5W, Willamette Meridian, Douglas County, Oregon.

Generally nine people or more in our family lived on the property for as long as I remember. My family and I made complete use of Melton Creek, continuously since 1885. We had the total use of all of the water in the creek. The water that now exists in the creek equals approximately one-half of the amount of water that used to flow through the creek. For more than ______ years 1 - Affidavit

we had exclusive use of the creek from its headwaters. No persons used or attempted to use any water below us for 10 - 15 years. Then in 1907 only limited use of the water of the creek was made below us, with our permission, when we did not need the water.

My family and I continually used water from the creek for all domestic purposes, washing of clothes, drinking and all of those household purposes. We also drew water from the creek to water our livestock on the property. All livestock possessed, including milk cows, horses, cattle and other farm animals, were watered from the creek.

Water from the creek was used to irrigate pasture land throughout the acreage and was used to irrigate land which had been plowed for garden purposes and the water was used to irrigate whatever crops were continually grown in the garden. This type of use of the creek continued and has continued until this date, until being challenged by the authorities from the office of the watermaster.

At all times referred to herein dams were placed in the creek to block and divert the water out of the creek for use on the property for irrigation and for general uses of the family on the property and in the pursuit of farming of the property by me and by my family.

It was not until the early 1930's when anyone attempted to divert water upstream from our property for any type of use. The upstream property holders always let enough water through in the creek for our complete uses as we had previously enjoyed and according to our needs on our own property which were consistent with the history of our general use of the property and the water to both irrigate our lands, water our livestock and provide water for all of our domestic purposes. Only in the last few years has the water been diverted, at times, to a point where there is insufficient

water to service our property and to water our livestock and provide for general domestic purposes.

Water from the creek is necessary for proper enjoyment and use of the 40 acres of property in question and to use the property as it has historically been used for more than 100 years.

The 40 acre property described herein was also served by springs adjacent to Melton Creek and at various locations on the property those springs were consistently used by me, my parents and our family for domestic purposes, watering the livestock, and irrigating. We used the entire water from the springs and from any area of flow or percolation from the ground adjacent to or on the property. This use existed since 1885 to present time.

This Affidavit is made in good faith and made for the purpose of supporting the application for water rights of WILLIAM L. FUMMERTON, grandson of WILLIAM and ANN MELTON, and CORA LEE FUMMERTON. The water right granted herein should predate any previous water right granted on this creek from the property in question to its headwaters. I am competent to testify to all of the facts set forth herein at any hearing or trial of the issues referred to herein.

to use the waters of MELTON CREEK, a tributary of TUCKER CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 1.0 ACRE AND DOMESTIC USE FOR TWO FAMILIES INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE LAWN AND NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN FOR EACH.

This Permit is issued approving Application 70388. The date of priority is MAY 31, 1990. The use is limited to not more than 0.023 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

It is further provided that the right allowed herein shall be limited during the period of March 31 through October 31 of each year to human consumption, livestock consumption for such animals as are essential to the proper sustenance of the family and irrigation of a noncommercial garden not to exceed 1/2 acre in area.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 12, T 28 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 1530 FEET NORTH AND 2390 FEET BAST, 2020 FEET NORTH AND 1450 FEET BAST, BOTH FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 12.

Diversion screening or fish passage facilities shall be designed, installed, and operated to Oregon Department of Fish & Wildlife specifications.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under this Permit is as follows:

> NE 1/4 SW 1/4 1.0 ACRE & DOMESTIC SECTION 12 TOWNSHIP 28 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 1, 1993, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1994. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1995.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.



Your application for a permit to use the public waters has been reviewed. Thank you for your time, effort and patience in completing this water right.

A "draft" permit is enclosed for your consideration. In the preparation of this draft permit, our staff has considered any public or agency comments received, as well as all pertinent Oregon laws, administrative rules and Commission policies.

The draft permit enclosed contains all of the conditions and limitations that would appear on your permit, if issued. Also, enclosed, for reference, are comments from Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW), dated December 4, 1991. ODFW recommends limiting water use other than domestic to December 1 through March 31 only of each year.

I spoke on May 5, 1992, to Mr. Robart of ODFW (229-5400), who confirmed the limitation requirement. Mr. Robart is aware you also have a Surface Water Registration (SWR) for rights similar to those on the application (I don't believe the SWR process will be affected at this time by issuance of or changes to Application 70388). To pursue changes on the draft regarding the limited period of use, it will be necessary for you to contact Mr. Robart directly (229-5400), and advise us of any negotiations.

Please review the draft permit <u>carefully</u>. If you are satisfied that the draft adequately describes your proposed use of water, and the terms are acceptable to you, please sign the draft copy in the spaces(s) provided and return to our office <u>within 30 days of the date of this letter</u>. We will issue our permit as quickly as possible.

We met with Mr. and Mrs. Fummerton on their property. He said his great-grandfather bought the property sometime before 1896. He said quite a bit more area had been irrigated in the past but the old ditch south of the road hasn't been used for many years. He identified three areas on the map which are being irrigated at present. I have circled the areas on the map.

He showed us the diversion point and the site of the old house. There were some very old fruit trees nearby. He said both diversion points have 1/2 hp electric pump motors and pipe systems to the three houses. There are sprinkler systems for the irrigation.

Mr. Fummerton said P.O.D. #1 uses about 75% of the water he diverts and P.O.D. #2 uses about 25% of the water he diverts.



That I make this Affidavit in support of the application for water rights, made by WILLIAM L. FUMMERTON and CORA LEE FUMMERTON and for the purposes of supplying the facts and history regarding the use of the water on Melton Creek.

I have lived on the land in question for 87 years, since 1900. This property is located on Melton Road and Melton Creek flows through the property. My parents lived on the property in question since 1885 and owned the original 40 acres in question generally known as the West half of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 12, Township 28S, R5W, Willamette Meridian, Douglas County, Oregon.

Generally nine people or more in our family lived on the property for as long as I remember. My family and I made complete use of Melton Creek, continuously since 1885. We had the total use of all of the water in the creek. The water that now exists in the creek equals approximately one-half of the amount of water that used to flow through the creek. For more than 100 years 1 - Affidavit

we had exclusive use of the creek from its headwaters. No persons used or attempted to use any water below us for 10 - 15 years. Then in 1907 only limited use of the water of the creek was made below us, with our permission, when we did not need the water.

My family and I continually used water from the creek for all domestic purposes, washing of clothes, drinking and all of those household purposes. We also drew water from the creek to water our livestock on the property. All livestock possessed, including milk cows, horses, cattle and other farm animals, were watered from the creek.

Water from the creek was used to irrigate pasture land throughout the acreage and was used to irrigate land which had been plowed for garden purposes and the water was used to irrigate whatever crops were continually grown in the garden. This type of use of the creek continued and has continued until this date, until being challenged by the authorities from the office of the watermaster.

At all times referred to herein dams were placed in the creek to block and divert the water out of the creek for use on the property for irrigation and for general uses of the family on the property and in the pursuit of farming of the property by me and by my family.

It was not until the early 1930's when anyone attempted to divert water upstream from our property for any type of use. The upstream property holders always let enough water through in the creek for our complete uses as we had previously enjoyed and according to our needs on our own property which were consistent with the history of our general use of the property and the water to both irrigate our lands, water our livestock and provide water for all of our domestic purposes. Only in the last few years has the water been diverted, at times, to a point where there is insufficient

water to service our property and to water our livestock and provide for general domestic purposes.

Water from the creek is necessary for proper enjoyment and use of the 40 acres of property in question and to use the property as it has historically been used for more than 100 years.

The 40 acre property described herein was also served by springs adjacent to Melton Creek and at various locations on the property those springs were consistantly used by me, my parents and our family for domestic purposes, watering the livestock, and irrigating. We used the entire water from the springs and from any area of flow or percolation from the ground adjacent to or on the property. This use existed since 1885 to present time.

This Affidavit is made in good faith and made for the purpose of supporting the application for water rights of WILLIAM L. FUMMERTON, grandson of WILLIAM and ANN MELTON, and CORA LEE FUMMERTON. The water right granted herein should predate any previous water right granted on this creek from the property in question to its headwaters. I am competent to testify to all of the facts set forth herein at any hearing or trial of the issues referred to herein.



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
