# Final Order Extension of Time for Permit Number G-12506

#### Appeal Rights

This is a final order in a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. A request for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either file for judicial review, or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

#### Application History

Permit G-12506 was issued by the Department on June19, 1996. The permit called for completion of construction by October 1, 1998 and complete application of water to beneficial use by October 1, 1999. On May 2, 2008, Brian and Susan Thompson - NW Farm Credit Services, PCA submitted to the Department an Application for Extension of Time for Permit G-12506. In accordance with OAR 690-315-0050(2), on April 21, 2009, the Department issued a Proposed Final Order proposing to deny the time to complete construction to October 1, 2012 and the time to fully apply water to beneficial use to October 1, 2012. The protest period closed May 29, 2009, in accordance with OAR 690-315-0060(1). No protest was filed.

The applicant has not demonstrated good cause for the permit extension pursuant to ORS 537.630, 539.010(5) and OAR 690-315-0040(2).
