Your application for an extension of the time limits in which to complete construction and make complete application of water under the terms of your permit number 39232 has been received. We also have your check in the amount of \$10.00.

The Water Resources Director is authorized to allow an extension of the time limits only upon a showing by the holder of the permit that reasonable diligence has been exercised toward completion of the project within the time limits allowed.

From the information given in your application, it is questionable whether sufficient diligence has been shown to justify the requested extension. However, you are being given the benefit of the doubt and the time limits to complete construction and make complete application of water are being extended to October 1, 1979, to allow you the opportunity to complete the appropriation.

You should make every attempt to complete the project on or before that date because it is doubtful if any further extensions can be granted.

Your application for a permit to appropriate 0.06 cubic foot of water per second from an unnamed stream and Little River, being 0.01 cubic foot of water per second from the unnamed stream for domestic use for one family and 0.05 cubic foot of water per second from the unnamed stream for the irrigation of 3.9 acres, with any deficiency to be made up from Little River, was received along with a map prepared on tracing paper, legal description in the remarks section of the application and fees in the amount of \$40.00.

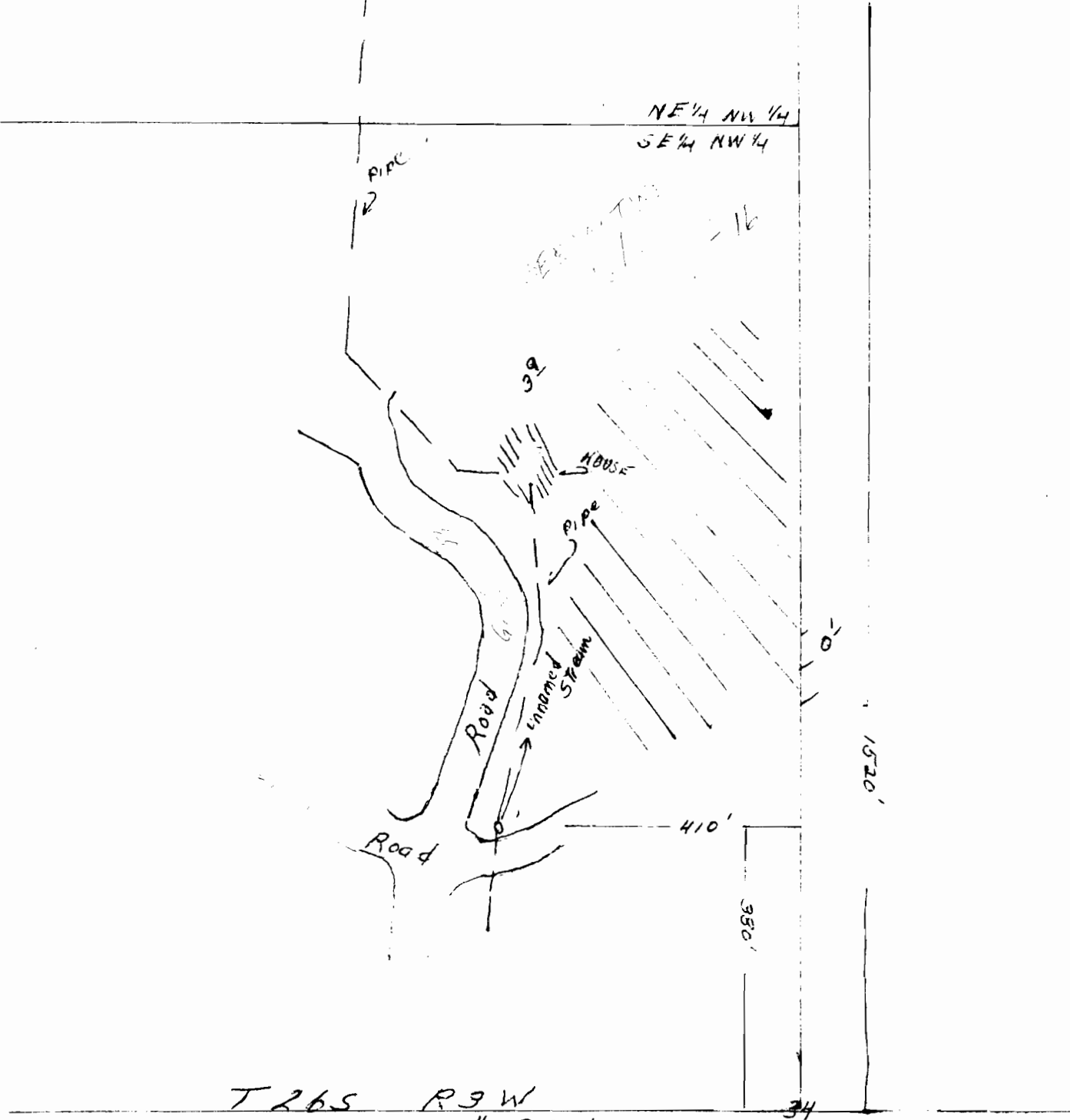
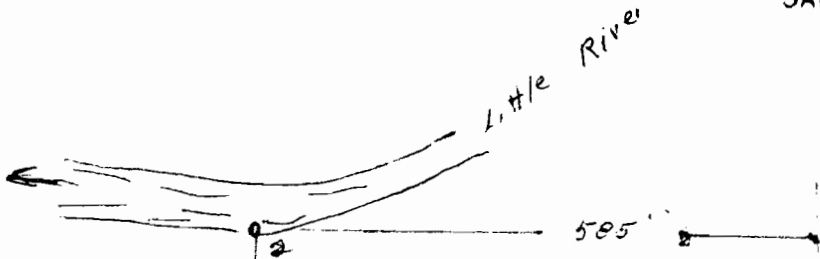

I talked to Gary Ball, <sup>WM for district 15,</sup> about point of diversion on unnamed stream. He said applicant went upstream to this point because unnamed stream goes subterranean. If diversion point were at site requested on application he would have to regulate the other two permits more and earlier.

Since there are only 2 other rights of record on this stream and both are junior to 39232 it will be less injurious to them to allow use from diversion in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , however we should only allow .005 cfs since that is all pipeline will carry by gravity flow to storage tanks. Little River will also be limited to .005 cfs since permit authorized it only for deficiency. Gary stated unnamed stream could have sufficient water to irr all 3.4 acres at times, but users restricted themselves to small allotment by capacity.

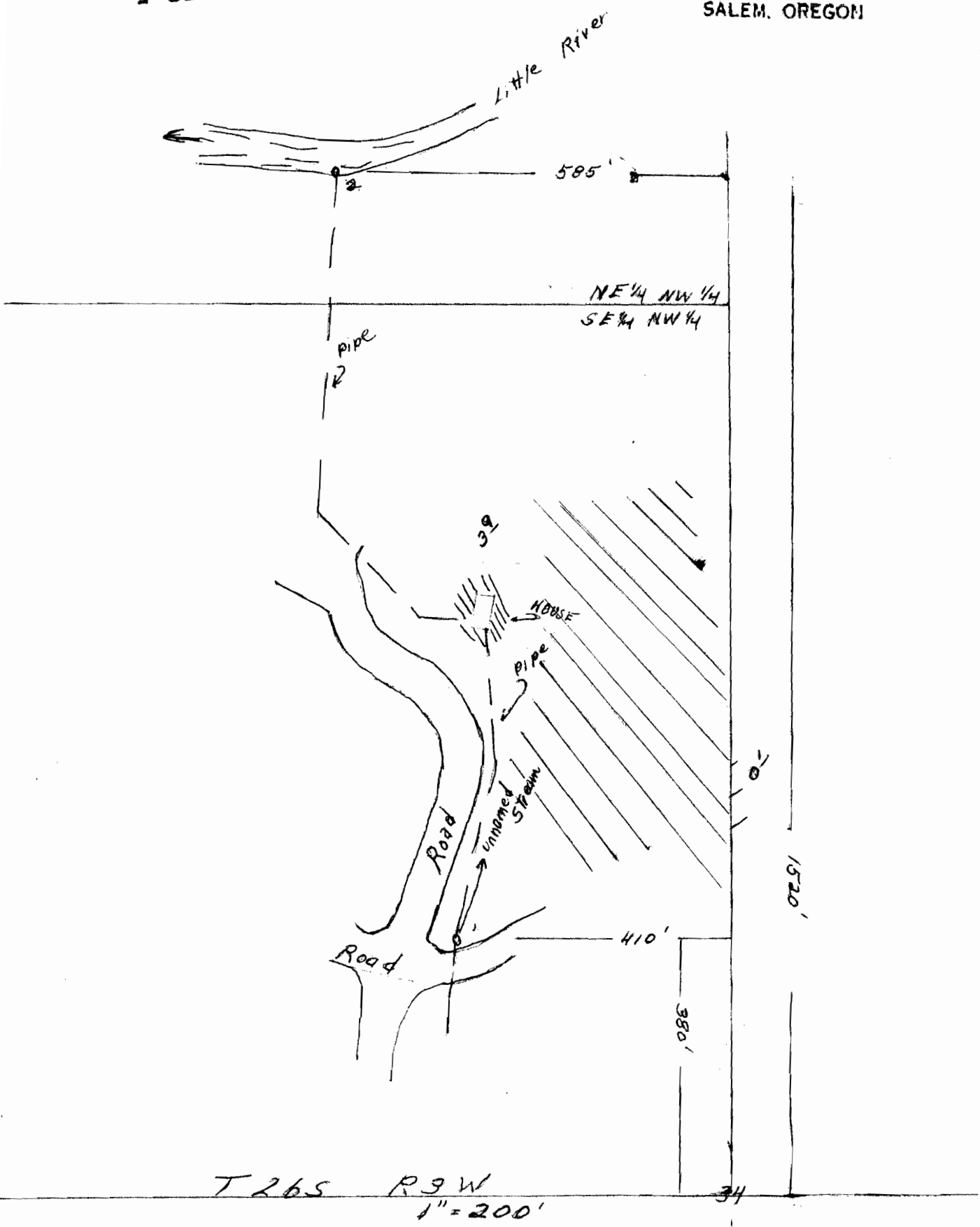

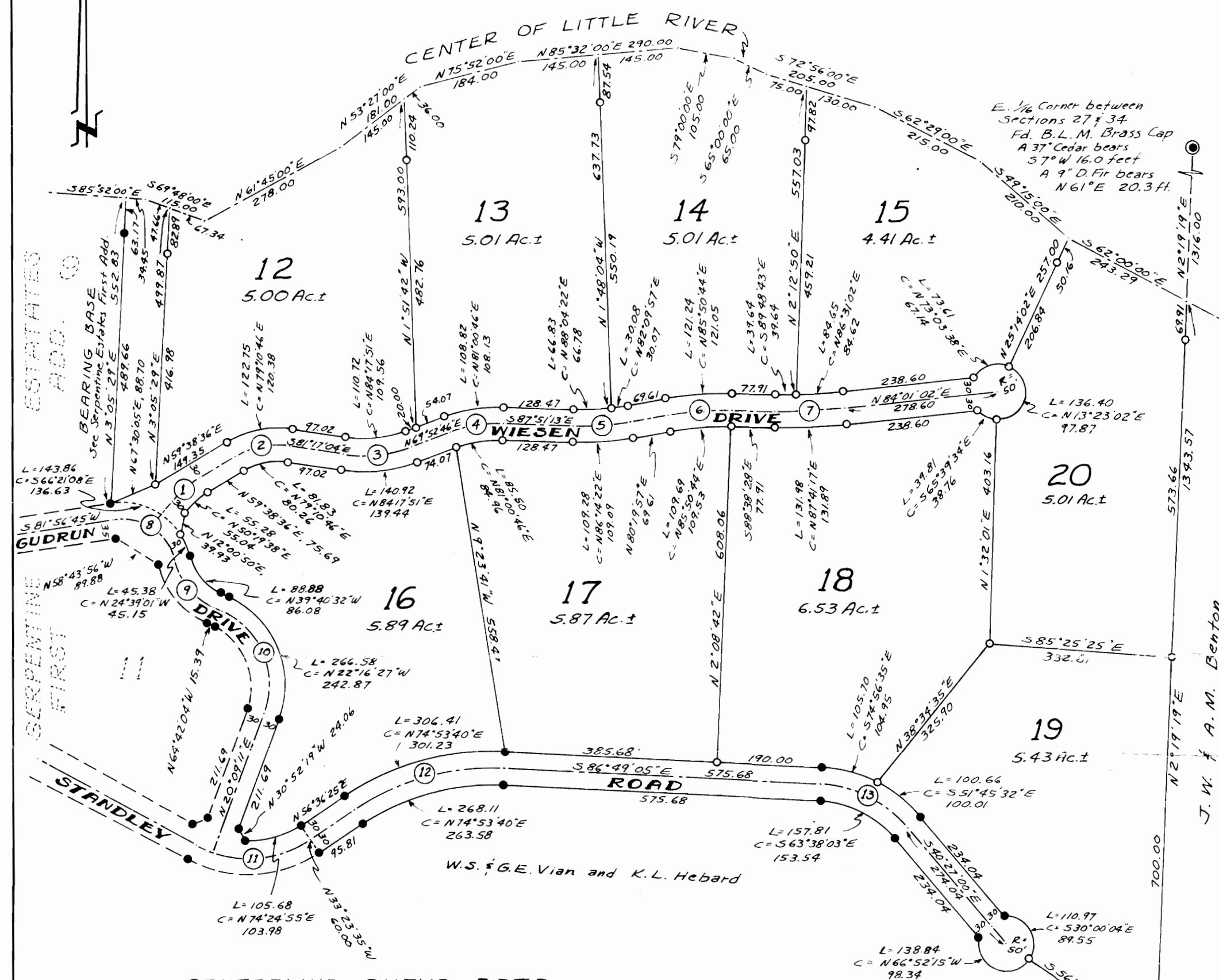
