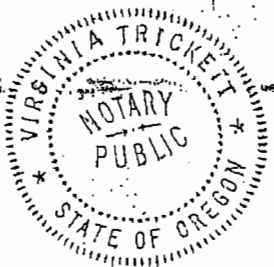

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that Buyer will promptly pay all public or private liens which may hereafter be lawfully imposed upon said premises before the same or any part thereof become past due.

It is agreed that there are no improvements upon the real property being sold by this contract.

It is agreed that in the event Buyer should fail to pay the taxes levied on the property before the same become delinquent, or to pay all liens before the same become past due, Sellers shall have the right to pay such taxes or liens, and the sums so paid will, at the option of Sellers, become payable by the Buyer on demand, or Sellers may add the same to the principal due hereunder.

Buyer hereby promises, covenants and agrees that it will make the payments as above specified, punctually at the times herein provided, and will well and truly perform all the promises and agreements required by this contract, by it to be performed.

It is understood and agreed that in case Buyer shall fail to make the payment aforesaid, or shall fail to keep any other term or condition of this agreement, time of payment and strict performance being declared to be of the essence of this agreement, within ten days of the receipt of written notice of such delinquency, then the Sellers shall have the right to declare this contract null and void, and of no further effect, and to retain all payments made hereunder as rent, or to foreclose this contract by strict foreclosure or to pursue any other remedy afforded Sellers at law or in equity for the foreclosure of this contract, or the collection of the unpaid balance thereof.

In case suit or action is instituted to foreclose this contract or to enforce any of the provisions thereof, the Buyer agrees to pay such sum as the Court may adjudge reasonable for attorney's fees in said suit or action.

Buyer hereby agrees that failure of Sellers at any time to require

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or before July 1, 1963, together with interest on such sum at the rate of 3% per annum from the date of this contract.

Buyer shall be entitled to possession of the property on the date of this contract, and real property taxes shall be prorated between the parties as of the date of this contract.

It is understood and agreed that an executed copy of this contract, together with a Warranty Deed executed by Sellers in favor of Buyer, conveying said property above described to Buyer, in fee simple and free and clear of all encumbrances except right, title and interest of the State of Oregon, arising by reason of any claim that any portion of the said property lies within the meandered bed of Tallcoos Lake, and a purchaser's policy of title insurance issued by a reputable company, showing title to be in Sellers, free and clear of all encumbrances except the exception above set forth, together with a release of the easement above referred to, shall be placed in escrow at Lane County Escrow Service, Inc., 978 Oak Street, Eugene, Oregon, with instructions to said escrow agent to deliver said documents to Buyer when it has fully performed this contract. Out of the last payment made on this contract, said escrow agent is authorized and instructed to deduct an amount sufficient to purchase internal revenue stamps, based upon a consideration of \$10,000.00, and to affix said stamps to the said deed, and an amount sufficient to purchase internal revenue stamps based upon the consideration of \$2,000.00, and to affix said stamps to said release of right of way.

It is agreed that the escrow entry fee shall be divided equally between the parties hereto, and that Buyer will, upon making each payment to the escrow agent, pay in addition to such payment, one-half of the collection fee for such payment, the other half to be deducted from the payment after it is credited upon the contract.

Buyer covenants that it will pay all taxes which may be levied or assessed against said property, subsequent to the date hereof, and
