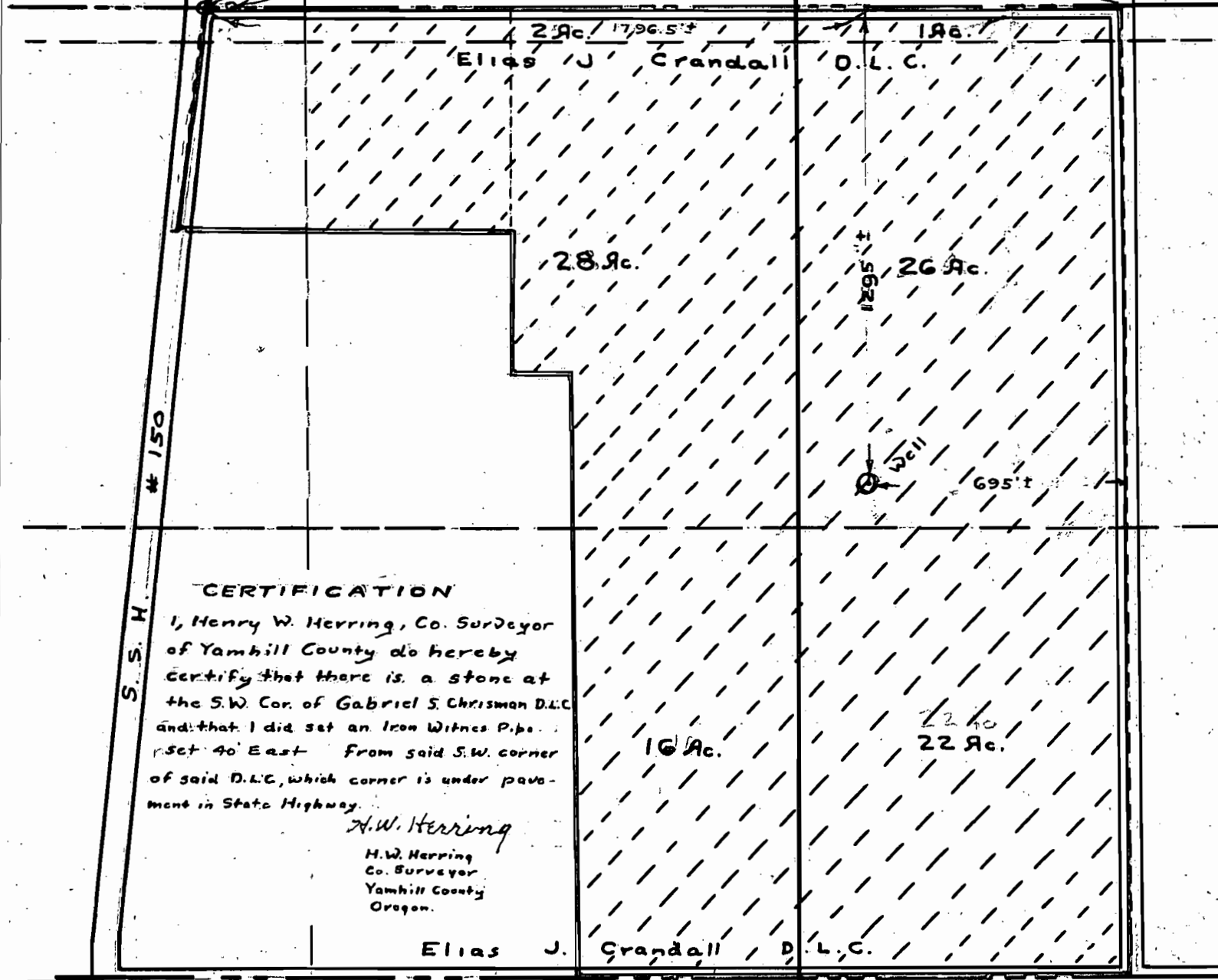
Plat of


