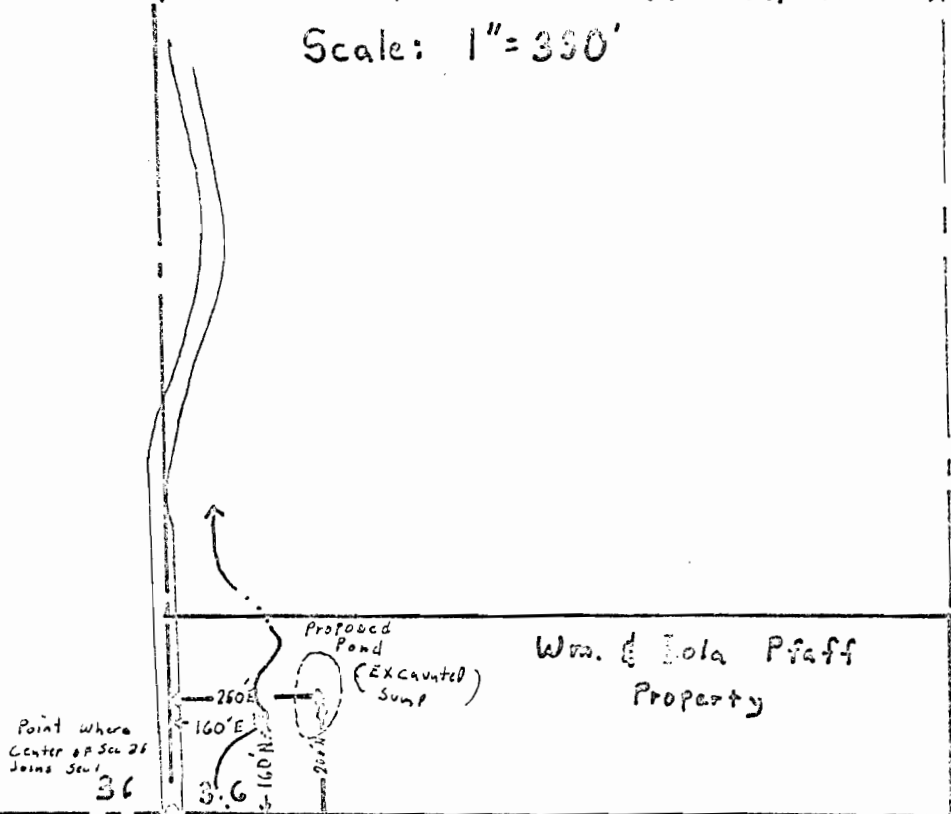

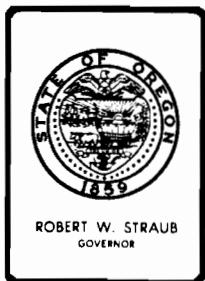

Dear Mr. & Mrs. Pfaff,

Under the terms of your permits R-6048 and 37286, the pond was to have been filled with water on or before October 1, 1975 and used for fish culture purposes only on October 1, 1976.

You may request an extension of time limits for each permit, but it is questionable that such an extension could be granted because of your comments regarding the abandonment of the project. I have enclosed an application form for your use. A fee of \$20.00 is required. Please go into quite a bit of detail regarding the amount of work done between March 1974 and March 1975. It will also be important for you to include the amount of work accomplished during the summers of 1975, 1976, and 1977. An extension of time can be granted if you have shown due diligence toward proceeding with the completion of the project for fish culture purposes.

If your request is granted, the time limits would probably be extended to October 1, 1978.

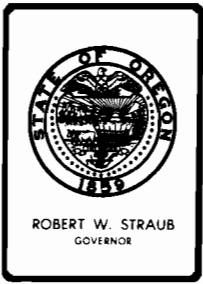
Since you intend to use the water for irrigation purposes, and perhaps fire control, you probably should authorize cancellation of permit R-6048 and 37286 because the use of water cannot be changed unless the terms of the permit have been satisfied and we have made a final proof inspection verifying the use of the water. A statement from both of you authorizing the cancellation of the permits would be adequate.

We will send you the necessary application forms when you are in a better position to carry out your irrigation or fire control project.

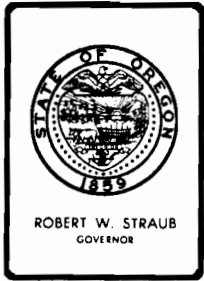

Thank you for your notice regarding the project described in your permits R 6048 & 37286.

Your permits only granted the use of water for fish culture purposes. If you intend to establish a water right for irrigation, you will have to submit an application for a new permit. We will send you the necessary form upon request.

If you intend to have a permanent fire suppression system, you may include this use of water on the application along with a description of your irrigation project. In the event you wish to store water for one or the other uses or both, a permit for this would also have to be acquired.

I have enclosed a form for your use in authorizing the cancellation of your permit R 6048 & permit 37286. Your authorization to cancel the permits will allow us to clear them from our records and avoid the necessity for further correspondence or notices.



Dear Mr. Pfaff:

This will acknowledge your application for a permit to construct a reservoir and store therein 2.3 acre feet of water from Beaver Creek for fish culture. The fees in the amount of \$20.00 were also received for which our receipt No. 33420 is enclosed. Your reservoir application has been filed and numbered R-50336.

This will acknowledge your secondary application for a permit to appropriate 0.029 cubic foot of water per second from Beaver Creek for fish culture. The map prepared on tracing paper, a copy of the warranty deed, and fees of \$25.00 were also received. Our receipt No. 33421 is enclosed. Your secondary application has been filed and numbered 50337.

The location of your reservoir should be given in item No. 6 of the reservoir application even though a dam will not be constructed. According to your map, the reservoir is located within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36, Township 7 North, Range 3 West. If so, this information should be given.

Since your proposed fish culture will utilize the stored water, the reservoir must be included as a source of water in item No. 1 of your secondary application No. 50337.

Rather than return the applications, I can add the required information to item No. 6 on the reservoir application and to item No. 1 on the secondary application if you will advise me of the correct location of the reservoir to be entered in item No. 6 of the reservoir application and to enter the reservoir as a source of water in item No. 1. I will need your written authorization to add this information to the applications.
