Under the terms of your permits R-6048 and 37286, the pond was to have been filled with water on or before October 1, 1975 and used for fish culture purposes only on October 1, 1976.

You may request an extension of time limits for each permit, but it is questionable that such an extension could be granted because of your comments regarding the abandonment of the project. I have enclosed an application form for your use. A fee of \$20.00 is required. Please go into quite a bit of detail regarding the amount of work done between March 1974 and March 1975. It will also be important for you to include the amount of work accomplished during the summers of 1975, 1976, and 1977. An extension of time can be granted if you have shown due diligence toward proceeding with the completion of the project for fish culture purposes.

If your request is granted, the time limits would probably be extended to October 1, 1978.

Since you intend to use the water for irrigation purposes, and perhaps fire control, you probably should authorize cancellation of permit R-6048 and 37286 because the use of water cannot be changed unless the terms of the permit have been satisfied and we have made a final proof inspection verifying the use of the water. A statement from both of you authorizing the cancellation of the permits would be adequate.

We will send you the necessary application forms when you are in a better position to carry out your irrigation or fire control project.

Thank you for your notice regarding the project described in your permits R 6048 & 37286.

Your permits only granted the use of water for fish culture purposes. If you intend to establish a water right for irrigation, you will have to submit an application for a new permit. We will send you the necessary form upon request.
