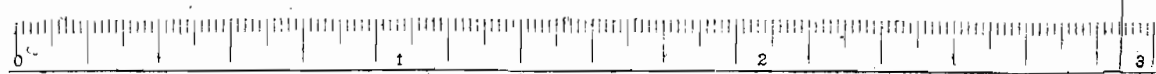
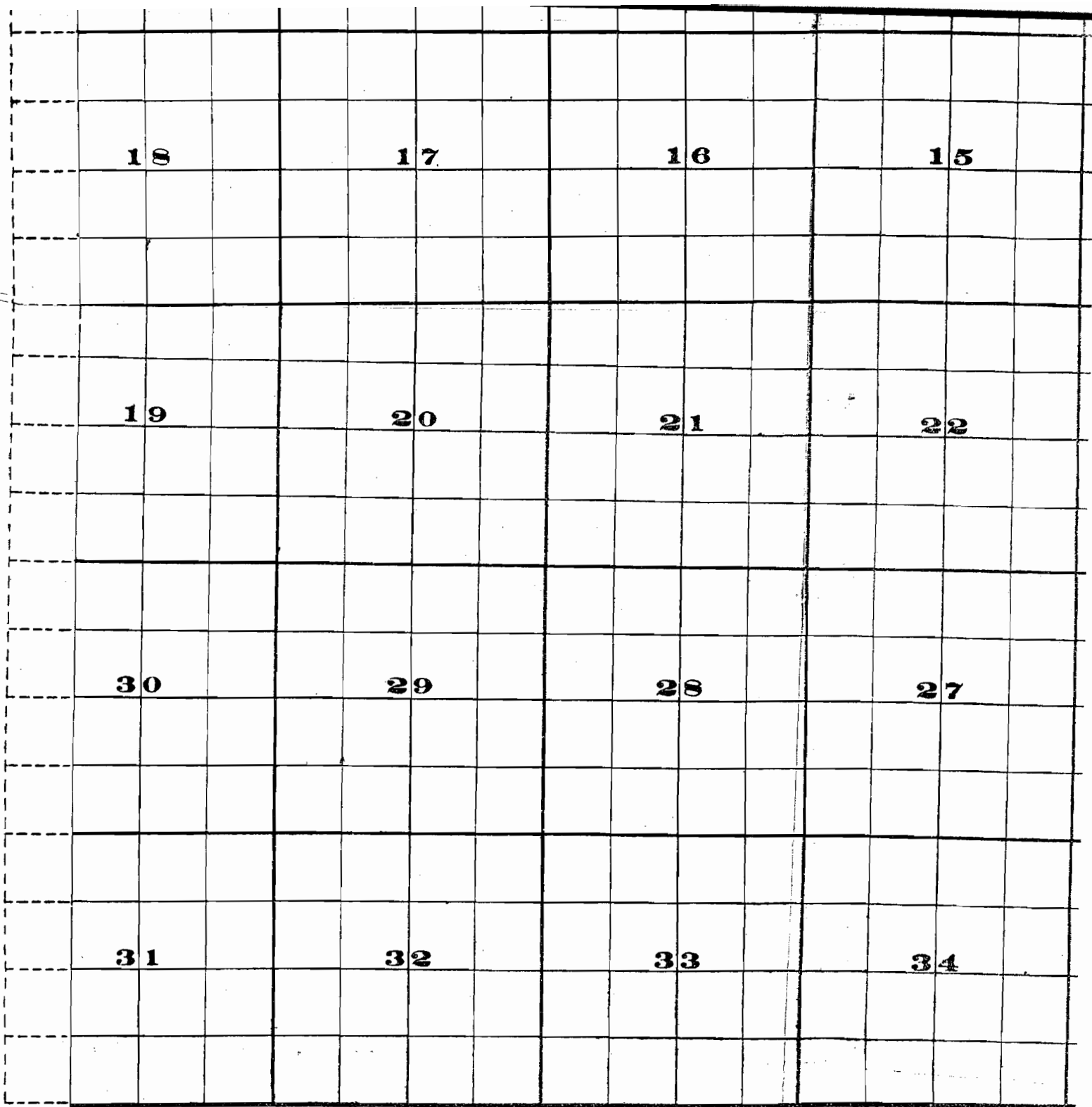

I note from the records of this office that you have not submitted final proof under your permit No. E 78 which covers the use of 0.25 second feet of water from Pine Creek for the irrigation of 20 acres of land, although final proof blanks were forwarded you for execution April 23, 1915. In view of the fact that final proof has not been submitted under this permit, we presume you have abandoned this water right and if so, we would be glad to have you authorize the cancelation of the permit on the records of this office as this will eliminate the necessity of following the regular procedure for the cancelation of the same.


