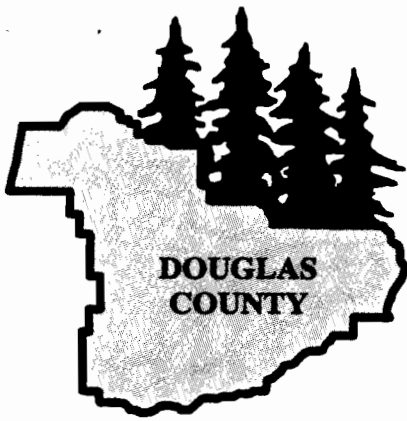

Example: 0.3 AF= \$325; 1.5 AF= \$350; 20.0 AF= \$800; 30.0 AF= \$1050. Plus a permit recording fee of \$400 (this fee is refunded if no permit is issued).

MEMORANDUM

TO: The Oregon Water Resources Department

FROM: Jonathan Wright, Administrative Planner *JW*

RE: A Land Use Compatibility Statement for the Oregon Water Resources Department (OWRD) to allow a water impoundment to store water for Irrigation.

This memo is informational only and does not constitute a decision by the Planning Department.

The above-referenced property is zoned Exclusive Farm Use Grazing (FG). Water impoundments constructed for the onsite storage of water for the purpose of irrigating farm crops is a permitted use in the FG zone. This proposed impoundment is in close proximity to an existing solid waste disposal facility. Interconnection between the proposed impoundment and the solid waste disposal facility is not permitted, and would require a process.

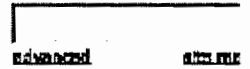
