Gentlemen:

According to the terms of your permit number G-1188 which is for the appropriation of 0.02 cubic foot per second of water from Well #2 for irrigation of 3.9 acres, complete use of water was to have been made on or before October 1, 1961.

On March 16, 1965, the proof of appropriation of water form in connection with this permit was mailed to you together with the instructions to sign the form and return it to this office together with the statutory recording fee of \$1.00.

On April 16, 1965, a reminder letter calling this to your attention was mailed. To date, we have not received either the proof or any correspondence regarding it.

ORS 537.260 provides: "Whenever the time within which any appropriation under a permit should have been perfected has expired and the owner of the permit fails or refuses within three months thereafter to submit to the State Engineer proof of completion of the appropriation as required by ORS 537.230 and 537.250, the State Engineer may, after 60 days notice by registered mail, order the cancelation of the permit."

In accordance with the provisions of ORS 537.260, you are hereby notified that unless we receive the signed proof form and the certificate recording fee within 60 days from the date of this letter, your permit will be canceled without further notice.

Gentlemen:

Examination of your Application No. G-1314 has disclosed the following defects:

Item 1: This item should be completed.

Item 3: Since the use of ground water for domestic use of up to 15,000 gallons of water per day is exempt from filing under the Ground Water Law, it would appear that the word "domestic" should be deleted. This quantity is considered adequate for 30 or more families. If domestic use will exceed the 15,000 gallons of water per day, an additional fee of \$10, as provided by law, will be required and also the location of use should be indicated under Item 12.

Item 8: This item should be completed.

Item 12: The area of use must be indicated within specific 1/16ths of a section.

Map: The map must indicate the area of use from well #2 by cross-hatching or shading differently from the area irrigated from well #1, unless both wells jointly serve entire area.

Items 14-18: These items should be completed.

The application and map are returned herewith, the application being endorsed so that in order to retain its date of priority it must be returned to this office on or before February 3, 1959.

Dear Mr. De Crevel:

We are in receipt of your application form for Well #2 and check in the amount of \$15 for which receipt 20534 is enclosed.

It is unfortunate that we did not detect on the original filing of the two registration statements last May that only one filing fee had been submitted. The State Statutes require that each filing be accompanied by a filing fee and we were, therefore, unable to establish two well registration filings to August 4, 1958, which marked the deadline of the registration period provided by the legislature.

ORS 537.605 states that the failure to file a registration statement prior to August 4, 1958, created the presumption that any claim to a vested ground water right has been abandoned and since Well #2 was not registered you were without a recorded water right.

It may be possible, at the time of adjudication, to show to the court that you have not abandoned your claim and the priority date of the water right certificate issued to you at the time of adjudication may be awarded an earlier priority date.

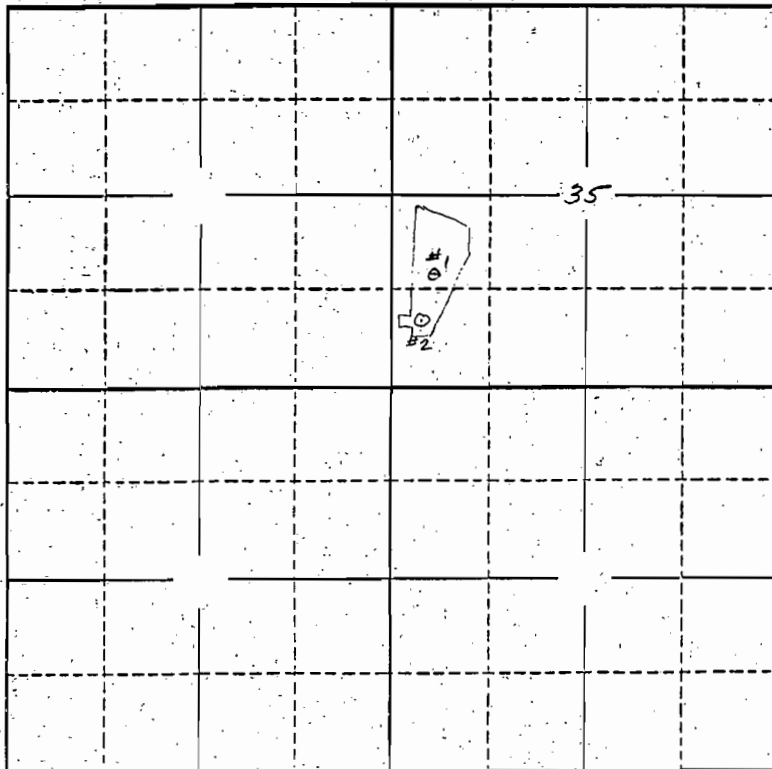

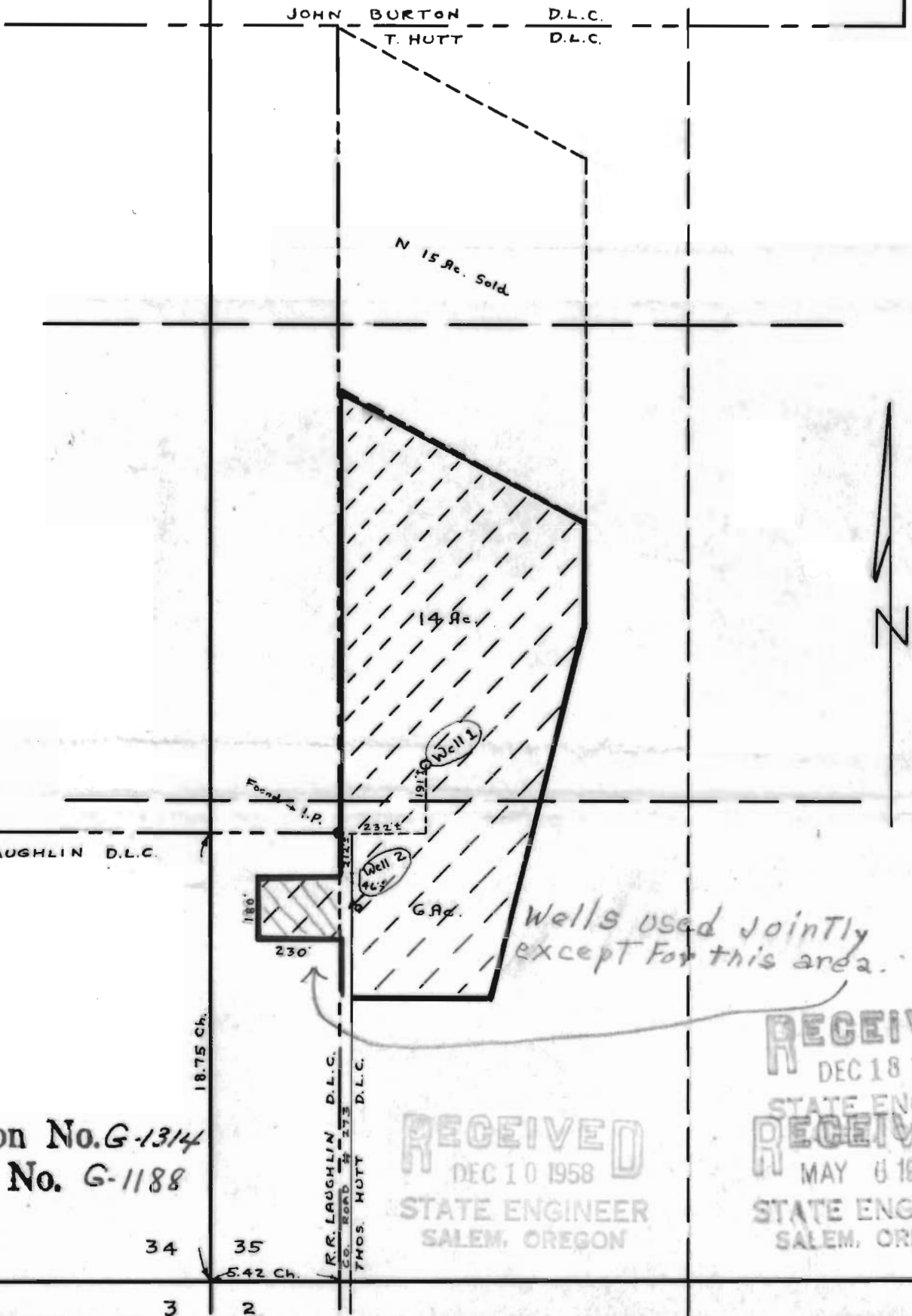
