To clarify the number of sources of water for application R-87555, there are 7 diversion points and 3 unnamed streams not 7 unnamed streams.

This letter should be considered an amendment to application G-17289. The amendments are:

#4A TYPE OF USE: Storage

#4B Amount of Water: Storage from both wells in an amount of 174.3 ac-ft

#4D Period of Use: Storage = storage season

By removing storage from the application the fee requirements are reduced to a total of \$2000.00. Any excess fees should be credited to future recording fees.

#7 REMARKS: With careful planning and management of about 30 different native seed crops and water, beneficial use of water can occur during a shorten irrigation season. The early part of the irrigation season is the most critical period of water use for the native seed plants. This is the period during which the plants are developing. They mature and begin to ripen during July. The native seed is usually harvested in August and September. Following harvest and into October it is desirable to irrigate the plants to prevent water stress and prepare the plants for the winter.

Water will be used only when the plants require moisture. We will monitor closely the amount of water the plants require and apply only the amount necessary for efficient plant growth.

We are requesting the Administrative Hold for this file be removed and processing continued.
