According to the terms of your permit No. 33088, for the appropriation of 0.38 cfs from McKay Creek for the irrigation of 30.0 acres, complete application of water was to have been made by October 1, 1971.


Complete application of water means the application of water to beneficial use under the permit to the full extent intended. In the case of irrigation, it means beneficial irrigation of all the lands the permittee intends to cover under the terms of the permit. If water has been used, you should promptly submit notice describing the extent of completion as set forth in the letter accompanying your permit and also in our postal card of October 13, 1971.

ORS 537.260 provides that: "Whenever the time within which any appropriation under a permit should have been perfected has expired and the owner of the permit fails or refuses within three months thereafter to submit to the State Engineer proof of completion of the appropriation as required by ORS 537.230 and 537.250, the State Engineer may, after 60 days' notice by registered mail, order the cancelation of the permit.*****"

In accordance with the provisions of ORS 537.260, you are hereby notified that unless proof of beneficial use is received within 60 days from the date of this letter, the permit(s) may be canceled without further notice.

If for any reason you are no longer interested in the project described by the permit, we would appreciate it if you would so advise. If the property involved has changed hands and any part of the project has been completed, you should immediately assign the permit to the new owner and advise us of his name and address. An assignment form will be furnished upon request.

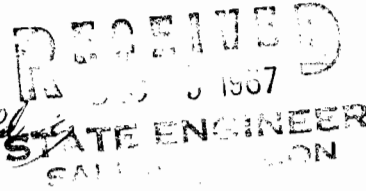

Dear Sir:

This will acknowledge receipt of your application for a permit to appropriate 0.38 cubic foot of water per second from McKay Creek for the irrigation of 30 acres, a map, and the fee of \$20 for which our receipt No. 6681 is enclosed.

During the recent years, McKay Reservoir has not filled and therefore would require the full flow of McKay Creek during the non-irrigation season for storage. The waters of McKay Creek are fully appropriated during the irrigation season. Therefore, except in extremely wet years, and then only during the early part of the season, you could not expect to appropriate any water under a permit that could be issued approving this application.

This application has therefore, not been filed. The \$20, which you submitted, has been placed in an open account in your name.

If, with the above stated information, you still wish to file this application for a permit to appropriate water from McKay Creek, we will do so at your request. If not, you should so indicate, and we will return the application map and \$20 submitted.

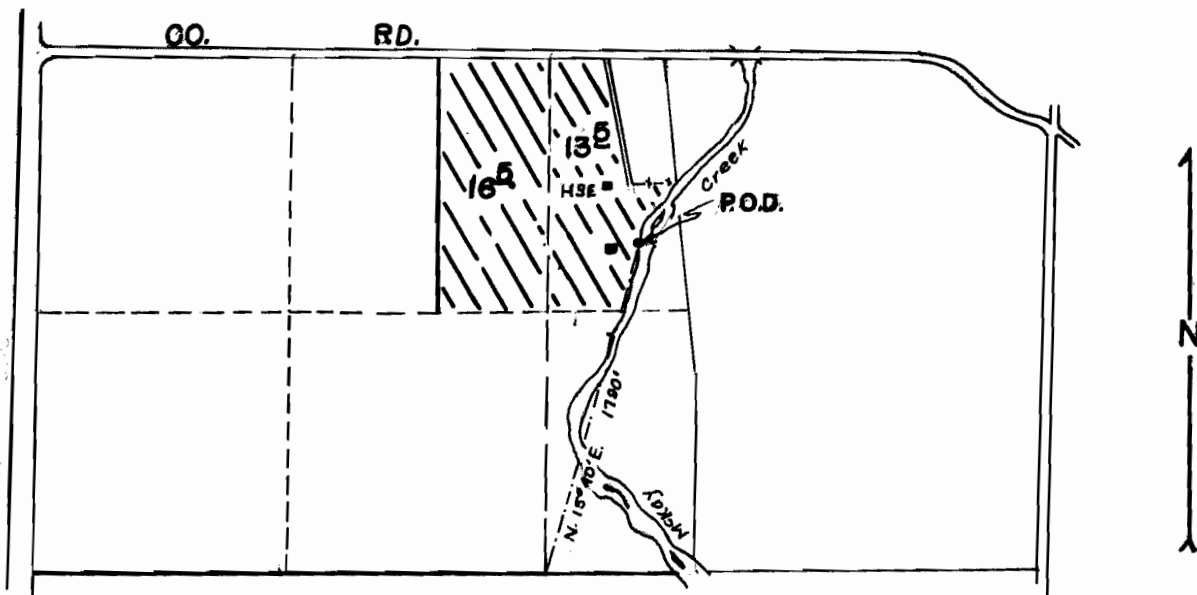

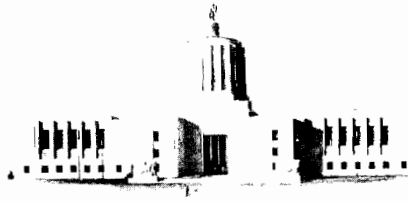


MAP TO ACCOMPANY APPLICATION FOR WATER RIGHT IN THE NAME
