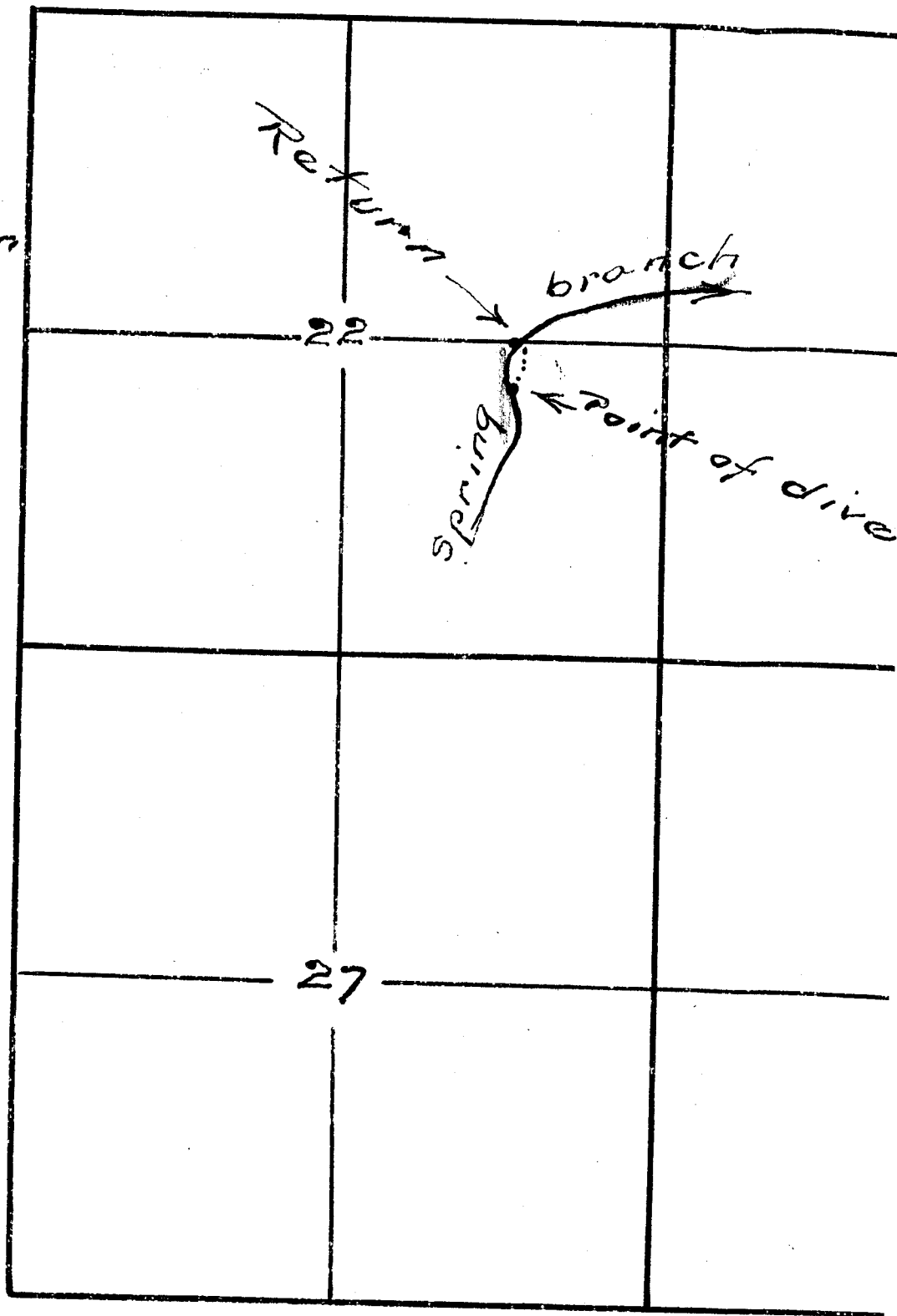

I note from the records of this office that you have filed no notices showing the progress of the work in perfecting your water right under permit No. 1511 which covers the use of 1 second foot of water from a spring branch for running a race and for domestic purposes, although the time for the completion of this water right as fixed in the permit expired October 9, 1915. In view of the fact that no notices have been filed, we presume you have abandoned this water right and if so, we would be glad to have you authorize the cancellation of the permit on the records of this office as this will eliminate the necessity of following the regular procedure for the cancellation of the same.
