

SECTION 8: REMARKS

The City of Eugene, acting through EWEB, submitted Surface Water Registration 354 to the Oregon Water Resources Department (Department) claiming a pre-1909 vested water right for the use of 30.9 cfs from the Willamette River for year-round municipal purposes. The registration indicated that development of this right began no later than November 3, 1886 and that water was first used March 26, 1887.

EWEB has had informal discussions with the Department regarding its willingness to adjudicate the Willamette River Basin so that the City can obtain a certificate for this water right. OWRD has indicated that due to budget and staffing restrictions, it does not intend to adjudicate the basin in the near term. As a result, EWEB is submitting this application for 30.9 cfs from the Willamette River to duplicate its existing unadjudicated pre-1909 water right. This water right is necessary because EWEB is currently dependent on the McKenzie River for its sole source of supply, and EWEB needs this right to have adequate certainty for significant and continued investment in its Willamette River water supply. EWEB intends to use its Willamette River water right for source water redundancy and operational flexibility.

EWEB is not requesting to increase the combined maximum authorized rate under its existing water rights through this application. Use of water under this water right, in combination with its existing rights, would be limited to the maximum rate currently authorized by EWEB's existing water rights. EWEB is not requesting "additional water" because the requested permit would not increase its maximum combined authorized rate under its existing water rights. The requested permit would provide EWEB with a redundant source of supply and operational flexibility.

B. How long is the amount of water requested in this application expected to meet future needs?

C. Briefly discuss operation of water system and the most constraining component of the system:

The greatest constraint on EWEB's water system is that it does not have an adequate redundant source of supply. Surface water from the McKenzie River is EWEB's sole source of supply. EWEB's groundwater permit is heavily conditioned and inadequate to meet EWEB's water supply needs.
