Hi Kathy,

The application proposed the use of 12 AF from Reservoir 1, to be constructed under Application R-87640, for irrigation, supplemental irrigation, and temperature control and the use of 40 AF from Applegate Reservoir for irrigation and supplemental irrigation. In the Initial Review, issued August 27, 2010, I used the "large" MRR condition which requires the installation of a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device prior to use of water. It is our standard practice to require "large" for any application proposing temperature control or nursery.

Norm Daft, on behalf of the applicant, requested that the "large" MRR condition **not** be required for the diversion from Reservoir 1. Mr. Daft stated that he had discussed this with you and that you had agreed that a staff gage would suffice as the measuring device for Reservoir 1 – is this true?
