Source of Water: A spring, tributary to Sattle Creek.

Rights Involved: Certificate 20787 issued to confirm Transfer No. M-19 and superseding certificate 1180.

This right was issued initially to the City of Turner for municipal purposes and defined the use of 1.00 cubic foot per second from a spring with a 1916 priority.

Transfer No. M-19 was to change the place of use and nature of use and the certificate defines the use of domestic, stock water and irrigation of 11.7 acres. The quantity of water on the certificate is 0.16 cubic foot per second.

Investigation: Disclosed that John H. Derksen was record holder of this right at the time of transfer. He stated that he has since sold a portion of the property on contract, including the right to the use of appurtenant water, to Mr. Otto Wienhold, Route h, Box 75 A, Turner, Oregon and has since built two houses on a portion of the property which he owned north of the county road. One is occupied by Dennis Derksen, Route 1, Box 75 H and the other by Mr. Derksen himself. His address is Route 1, Box 75 J.

On the evening of June 13, I contacted Mr. Derksen and explained to him that he was appropriating water illegally and that unless some means could be found to provide a right for this use of water, he would be forced to cease appropriation.
