You'll recall that a couple weeks ago we discussed my request to move a proposed point of diversion on my ground water application (G-17442) so that it would lie farther from a stream, Owl Creek. Please find attached a revised map on which I have moved "POA #3" to the far northeast corner of our property in order to have that point in excess of a quarter mile from the creek.


On the attached sheet I've also detailed the information for this POA per Section 3 of the ground water application. I hope this will be sufficient to append to my existing application. All other references to POA #3 in the application should remain the same.

I think we agreed that as long as I was not adding a new POA that I would not be assessed further charges. I have merely moved POA #3 to the new location in the event, after further consideration, POA #1 & #2 are still considered unsuitable by the ODFW because of their proximity to Owl Creek.
