

NOTICE OF BEGINNING OF CONSTRUCTION

I, E.H. Colgan, the holder of Application No. 5615, being Reservoir Permit No. 3477, issued by the State Engineer of the State of Oregon for the appropriation of 0.25 second-feet of the waters of Marion creek in accordance with the tenor of such permit and the limitations endorsed thereon by the State Engineer, began the actual construction of the works described therein on the 15 day of July, 1918, being within the time limitation as fixed in said permit for the beginning of construction work.

NOTICE OF COMPLETE APPLICATION OF WATER TO A BENEFICIAL USE

I, E.H. Colgan, the holder of Application No. 5615, being a small dam Permit No. 3477, issued by the State Engineer of the State of Oregon for the appropriation of 0.25 second-feet of the waters of Marion creek in accordance with the tenor of such permit and the limitations endorsed thereon by the State Engineer, completely applied the water to a beneficial use, on the 15th day of August, 1919, being the time limitation as fixed in said permit or extended by the State Water Board for the complete application of water to a beneficial use.

Remarks: My ditch was all dug and water applied the first year of the permit and all this complete
If all of the water granted in the permit had not been fully applied to beneficial use, you should so state, so that delinquent appropriators may have notice.

NOTICE OF COMPLETION OF CONSTRUCTION

I, E.H. Colgan, the holder of Application No. 5616, being a small dam Permit No. 3477, issued by the State Engineer of the State of Oregon for the appropriation of 0.25 second-feet of the waters of Marion creek in accordance with the tenor of such permit and the limitations endorsed thereon by the State Engineer, have completed the construction of the works described therein the 15th day of August, 1919, being within the time limitation as fixed in said permit or extended by the State Water Board for the completion of construction work.

Remarks:
If the works have a less capacity than as described in the permit, or you have definitely abandoned your plan of irrigating any of the lands described in your permit, you should so state in order that our records may not be unnecessarily encumbered.

Dear Mr. Heis:

A search of our records in regard to the property identified by the legal description and sketch received with your letter of July 5 discloses four rights of record which are appurtenant, at least in part, to the subject lands.

The certificate recorded at page 2132, State Record of Water Rights Certificates, was issued in the name of G. E. Colgan in evidence of the right established under permit No. 3477 to appropriate not to exceed 0.05 second feet of water from Marion Creek, with the priority date of August 7, 1917, for irrigation of 4 acres within the NW 1/4 of Section 26, Township 9 South, Range 2 West, V.M.

The certificate recorded at page 21149 was issued in the name of William A. and Genevieve Kirsh in evidence of the right established under permit No. 15418 to appropriate not to exceed 0.25 second feet of water from Marion Creek within the SW 1/4 of Section 26, Township 9 South, Range 2 West, V.M., with the priority date of November 30, 1942, for irrigation of 7 acres in government lot 7 and 11 acres within the SW 1/4 of said Section 26.

The certificate recorded at page 21224 was issued in the name of William A. Kirsh in evidence of the right established under permit No. 19588 to appropriate not to exceed 0.21 cubic feet per second of water from Marion Creek within the SW 1/4 of Section 26, Township 9 South, Range 2 West, V.M., with the priority date of October 17, 1950, for irrigation of 6.1 acres in lot 7, 3.0 acres in lot 5 and 7.4 acres in the SW 1/4 of said Section 26.

The certificate recorded at page 26120, also in the name of William Kirsh, was issued in evidence of the right established under permit No. 21364 to appropriate not to exceed 0.17 second feet of water from Marion Creek within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, Township 9 South, Range 2 West, W.M., for irrigation of 5.6 acres in the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Lot 6 and 7.9 acres in the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Lot 5 of said Section 28.

Dear Sir:

I am enclosing blank for proof of appropriation of water under permit No. 3477.

I note that you have until October 1, 1920 within which to completely apply the water to the proposed use under this permit. If all the water which you contemplate using under this permit has not been used, you should withhold the enclosed proof until the expiration of the time allowed for the completion of your right, or until such time as you have applied all the water which you intend to use. However, if all the water which you desire to use under this permit has been used, you should fill out and return the enclosed proof, together with \$1.00 to cover recording fee, and the matter will be presented to the Board at its next meeting for approval and issuance of final water right certificate.
