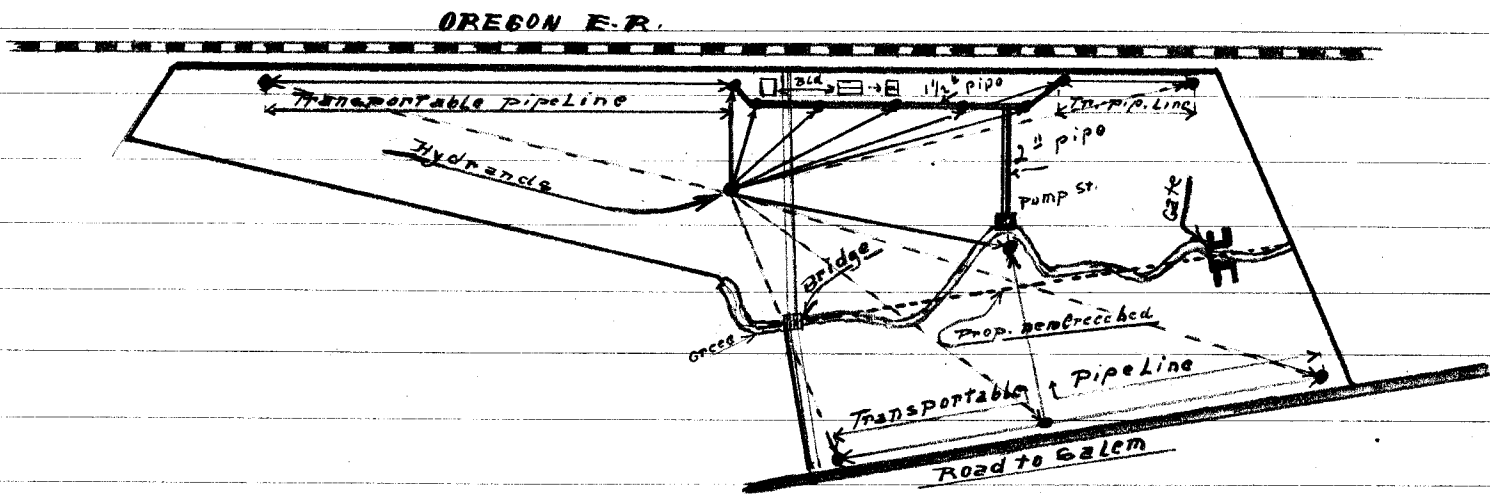

Upon taking up for approval your Application No. 6573, I note that the area to be irrigated within each 40-acre tract is not stated under Question No. 9. The map would indicate that a small part of the 40 acres is within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$, and within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, while the main part of the tract lies within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23.

We would like to have an estimate of the amount of the land within each 40-acre tract given under Question 9 of the application.

In accordance with your request, I am enclosing four blue prints of the map which you have filed.

The fee provided by law for making these blue prints is fifty cents.
