Form A

I, John Graber, the holder of Application No. 7256, being Permit No. 5572, issued by the State Engineer of the State of Oregon for the appropriation of 2.5 second-feet of the waters of unnamed spring and Pringle Creek in accordance with the tenor of such permit and the limitations endorsed thereon by the State Engineer, began the actual construction of the works described therein during the summer of 1922, being within the time limitation as fixed in said permit for the beginning of construction work.

I, John Graber, the holder of Application No. 7256, being Permit No. 5572, issued by the State Engineer of the State of Oregon for the appropriation of 2.5 second-feet of the waters of unnamed spring in accordance with the tenor of such permit and the limitations endorsed thereon by the State Engineer, have completed the construction of the works described therein the 30 day of May, 1924, being within the time limitation as fixed in said permit or extended by the State Water Board for the completion of construction work.
